



Teddy Snuggle Rag - Rabbit

No. 1001-171-3055

Materials:

Crochet Hook US sizes C/2-D/3 (3 mm), G/6 (4 mm) and H/8 (5 mm)

Go Handmade Teddy yarn

Go Handmade Soft yarn

Go Handmade embroidery yarn

1 set of safety eyes 5mm.

A little filling

Abbreviations:

Mr: Magic ring

Ch: Chain

St: Stitch

Sl st: Slip Stitch

Sc: Single crochet

Dc: Double crochet

Measurements: 10x10 inches
(26x26 cm)

Usage:

Soft yarn approx. 0.7 oz (20 g)

Teddy yarn approx. 2.3 oz (65 g)

The rag:

- Worked in Teddy yarn on hook H/8.
- The sample in the pictures is worked in Soft yarn so it's easier to see what to do.
- The rag is made like a granny square like this:

1. Make a mr. Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc into the ring and make 2 ch. Work "3 dc into the ring and make 2 ch". Repeat "to" another 2 times and finish with 1 sl st. Tighten the ring.



Make a mr. Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc into the ring.



Make 2 ch.



Work 3 dc into the ring and work 2 ch.



Work "3 dc into the ring and make 2 ch". Repeat another 2 times and finish with 1 sl st. Tighten the ring.

2. Now work sl st to the first ch gap. Make 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 2 dc, 2 ch and 3 dc into the ch gap followed by 1 ch. Work “3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc, 1 ch” in the next ch gap. Repeat “to” in the next 2 ch gaps. Finish with 1 sl st.



Now work sl st to the first ch gap.



Make 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 2 dc



2 ch and 3 dc into the ch gap followed by 1 ch.



Work “3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc, 1 ch” in the next ch gap.



Repeat “to” in the next 2 ch gaps. Finish with 1 sl st.

3. Now work ch to the first ch gap. Make 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 2 dc, 2 ch and 3 dc into the ch gap followed by 1 ch. Work 3 dc followed by 1 ch in each ch gap on the sides. In every corner ch gap work “3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc, 1 ch”. Repeat around and finish with 1 sl st.



Now work ch to the first ch gap



Make 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 2 dc, 2 ch and 3 dc into the ch gap followed by 1 ch.



Work 3 dc followed by 1 ch in each ch gap on the sides.



In every corner ch gap work “3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc, 1 ch”.



Repeat around and finish with 1 sl st.

4. Repeat this round on the rag until you have 8 rounds. Next round is worked the same way but in the corners, work 3 dc, 10 ch. Now work sc back in the 10 ch and work 3 dc in the ch gap. Repeat this in all 4 corners. Finish and weave in ends.



Tie knots on the sc string you made in the corners.



If you want the rag to be in more colors, just cut the yarn and instead of working sl st to the ch gap, attach the new color in one of the corners.

Head:

- Worked in 2 strands of Soft yarn on hook C/2-D/3.
- 1. Make a mr and work 6 sc in the ring (6)
- 2. Work 2 sc in each st around (12).
- 3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next". Repeat around (18).
- 4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 st, 2 sc in the next". Repeat "to" around (24).
- 5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 st, 2 sc in the next". Repeat "to" around (30).
- 6. Work "1 sc in the next 4 st, 2 sc in the next". Repeat "to" around (36).
- 7. Work "1 sc in the next 5 st, 2 sc in the next". Repeat "to" around (42).
- 8. Work sc around (42).
- 9. Work sc around (42).
- 10. Work sc around (42).
- 11. Work sc around (42).
- 12. Work sc around (42).
- 13. Work "1 sc in the next 5 st, 2 sc tog in the next st". Repeat "to" around (36).
- 14. Work "1 sc in the next 4 st, 2 sc tog in the next st". Repeat "to" around (30).
- 15. Work "1 sc in the next 3 st, 2 sc tog in the next st". Repeat "to" around (24). Insert eyes between rounds 8-9 with 3-4 st between them.
- 16. Work "1 sc in the next 2 st, 2 sc tog in the next st". Repeat "to" around (18). Start filling the head before the hole gets too small.
- 17. Work "1 sc in the next st, 2 sc tog in the next". Repeat "to" around (12).
- 18. Work "2 sc tog". Repeat "to" around (6) Sew up the hole.

Leave a string for sewing.

Opt. make dents at the eyes by sewing in behind the eyes and tightening until you've got the dent you want.

Opt. embroider snout and eye brows with Go Handmade Embroidery yarn in the wanted color. Here I've chosen the snout in a darker pink than the head.



Ears:

- Worked in Teddy Yarn on hook G/6. Make 2.
- 1. Work 3 ch, make 1 dc in 3rd ch from the hook (2 dc).
- 2. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 2 dc in the next st (3).
- 3. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 1 dc in the next st and 2 dc in the last st (4).
- 4. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 1 dc in the next 2 st and 2 dc in the last st (5).
- 5. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 1 dc in all st(5).
- 6. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 1 dc in the next 2 st, work 2 dc tog (4).
- 7. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 1 dc in the next st, work 2 dc tog (3).
- 8. Turn with 3 ch (replaces 1st dc). Work 2 dc tog (2).

Leave a string for sewing.



Arms:

- Worked in 2 strands of Soft yarn on hook C/2-D/3. Make 2.
 1. Make a mr and work 5 sc in the ring (5).
 2. Work "2 sc in each st". Repeat "to" around (10).
 3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around (15).
 4. Work sc around (15).
 5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 st, 2 sc tog". Repeat "to" around (12).
 6. Work sc around (12).
 7. Work sc around (12).
 8. Work sc around (12).
 9. Work sc around (12).
 10. Work sc around (12).
 11. Work sc around (12).
 12. Work sc around (12).
 13. Work sc around (12).
 14. Work sc around (12).
 15. Work sc around (12).
 16. Work sc around (12).

Now crochet the sides together like in the picture below.



Assembling:

Sew the ears on to the head. I chose to sew them on at round no. 4 on the head.

Sew the arms on under the head and then sew it all on in the middle of the rag.
