Materials:

Crochet Hook size no. H/8
Go Handmade Teddy yarn

Buy yarn and supplies here:

Measurements: approx. 29.53 x 29.53 inches.

Usage: approx. 14.1 oz. (8 skeins)

Abbreviations:

Mr: Magic ring

Ch: chain

st: stitch

ss: slip stitch

dc: double crochet

Pattern:

- The blanket is made with Teddy yarn on hook size H/8.
- We have used cotton yarn in the visual guide so it is easier to see and follow.
- The blanket is crocheted like a granny square like this:

1. Start with a magic ring. Chain 3 (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc into the mg and ch 2. Work *3 dc into the magic ring and ch 2*. Repeat *-* twice and finish with a ss. Tighten the ring slightly.

- Now, work ss to the first chain space. Chain 3 (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc into the chain space followed by ch 1. Work *3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1* in the next chain space. Repeat *-* in the next 2 chain spaces. Finish with a ss.



Now, work ss to the first chain space



Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc



Ch 2, and 3 dc into the chain space followed by ch 1



Work *3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1* in the next chain space.



Repeat *-* in the next 2 chain spaces. Finish with a ss.

3. Work ss to the first chain space. Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc into the chain space followed by a 1 ss. On the sides of the granny square, you work 3 dc followed by ch 1 in each chain space. In the corners , you work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1. Repeat all the way round, and finish with 1 ss.



Work ss to the first chain space



Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc). Work 2 dc, ch 2, and 3 dc into the chain space followed by a 1 ss.



On the sides of the granny square, you work 3 dc followed by ch 1 in each chain space.



In the corners , you work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1. Repeat all the way round, and finish with 1 ss.



Repeat all the way round, and finish with 1 ss.

4. Repeat the instructions above until you have 26 rounds or until you reach the desired length. The next round is worked in the same way except in the corners you work “knots” like this:



Ch 3, and work 2 dc in the chain space in the corner. Instead of chaining 2 like previously, you chain 15.



In the 3rd ch from the needle, work 1 dc. Now, work dc in each chain stitch all the way back.



Turn by ch 3 and work dc all the way around.

Work 1 ss in the last crocheted dc in the chain space.



Work 3 dc in the chain space. Work your way around the square as you normally would, and repeat this “knot-technique” in the remaining 3 corners.



Now your corner should look like this.



Tie a knot.

Weave in ends and enjoy your soft cuddle blanket :-)

If you want a multi-colored version of the blanket, you just start up with the new color in one of the corners by working 1 ss in the chain space with the new color instead of working 1 ss in the chain space with the old color.
