

## Crochet Ribbon - Christmas Stocking

## Materials:

Crochet hook size 6 mm
Hobbii Ribbon
Measurements: Approx. 65 cm long and 24
cm wide
Buy your yarn here:

## Usage:

Grey approx. 180 gr
Red approx. 475 gr

## Abbreviations:

Mr: Magic ring
Ch: Chain stitch
St(s): Stitch(es)
Sc: Single crochet
Sl st: Slip stitch
Tog: Together
Tbl: Through back loop

## Pattern:

## Use grey

1. Make a mr and work 8 sc in ring. (8)
2. Work 2 sc in each st on entire round. (16)
3. Work " 1 sc in next st, and 2 sc in next". Repeat "to" on entire round. (24)
4. Work " 1 sc in the next 3 st, and 2 sc in next" Repeat "to" on entire round. (30)
5. Work " 1 sc in the next 4 st, and 2 sc in next" Repeat "to" on entire round. (36)
6. Work " 1 sc in the next 5 st, and 2 sc in next" Repeat "to" on entire round. (42)
7. Work " 1 sc in the next 6 st, and 2 sc in next" Repeat "to" on entire round. (48)
8. Work " 1 sc in the next 7 st, and 2 sc in next" Repeat "to" on entire round. (54)
9. Work sc in the round. (54)
10. Work " 1 sc in the next 8 st, and 2 sc in next" Repeat "to" on entire round. (60)
11. Work sc in the round. (60)
12. Work sc in the round. (60)
13. Change to red. Work sc in the round. (60)
14.     - 33. Work sc in the round. (60) Cut the yarn.


## Heel:

With grey

1. Attach yarn with 1 sl st, 14 stitches from the last worked stitch. Work 1 sc in the next 28 stitches. (28)

2. Turn with ch 1 and work 1 sc in each stitch. (28)
3. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in the next $22 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in last st (26)
4. Turn with ch 1 . Work 1 sc in all stitches. (26)
5. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in the next $20 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in last st (24)
6. Turn with ch 1 . Work 1 sc in all stitches. (24)
7. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in the next $18 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in last st (22)
8. Turn with ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the next $9 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 2 sc tog, 1 sc in the last 9 st (20)
9. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in the next $14 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in last st (18)
10. Turn with ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the next 7 st, 2 sc tog, 2 sc tog, work 1 sc in the last 7 st (16)
11. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, work 1 sc in the next $10 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in last st (14)
12. Turn with ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the next $5 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 2 sc tog, 1 sc in the last 5 st (12)
13. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in the next $6 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in last st (10)
14. Turn with ch 1 . Work $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc tog 4 times, 1 sc in last st (6)


This is how the heel looks like now.


Sew end of heel together from WS. The heel is now finished.

## Shaft:

With red

1. Insert yarn from RS in sock as shown on picture below. Work 1 sc in 32 st along edge until the heel begins, work 14 sc along one side of heel, continue with 14 sc along the other side of the heel. (60)


Work from RS of sock.


Work 1 sc in the next 32 st until the beginning of the heel.


Attach the red yarn.


Now work 14 sc along one side of the heel.


And 14 sc along the other side of the heel.
2. Work sc in all stitches in the round. (60)
3. Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in the next $28 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog, 1 sc in the last 28 st (58)
4. Work sc in all stitches in the round. (58)
5. Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in the next 26 st, 2 sc tog, work 1 sc in the last 28 st (56)
6. Work sc in all stitches in the round (56)
7. Work sc in all stitches in the round (56)
8. Work 1 sc in the next 13 st, 2 sc in next. Work sc in the last 42 st (57)
9. Work sc in all stitches in the round (57)
10. Work 1 sc in the next $14 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next. Work 1 sc in the last 42 st (58)
11. Work sc in all stitches in the round (58)
12. Work 1 sc in the next $15 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next. Work 1 sc in the last 42 st (59)
13. Work sc in all stitches in the round. (59)
14. Work 1 sc in the next 16 st, 2 sc in next. Work 1 sc in the last 42 st (60)
15. - 40. Work sc in all stitches in the round. (60)

Finish with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn


## Edge:

With grey

1. Change to grey and work 1 sc in all stitches in the round. (60)
2. Work sc in every stitch in the round, finish with 1 sl st. (60)

3. Turn piece inside out, so you now work from WS of sock. Now work sc tbl on entire round.

4.     - 10 Work sc in all stitches in the round (60)

Finish with 1 sl st, cut the yarn and bind off.


The edge is now finished.


Fold the edge over sock.

## Strap:

With red

1. Ch 25 and work 1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook. Continue with 1 sc in every st on the rest of the row. (24)
2. Turn with ch 1 . Work sc in every st on entire row. (24)
3. Turn with ch 1 . Work sc in every st on entire row. (24) Cut yarn and leave tail for assembly.
