



Lollipop Scarf/Shawl

No. 1001-171-5609

Materials:

- Crochet Hook H- 5mm (If you crochet tight, you can use size I- 5.5mm)
- Hobbii Lollipop

Buy the yarn for this pattern here:

Measurements: Approx. 70 x 30 in.

The size can vary by making more or fewer rows.

Uses: Approx. 375 g (13.2 oz) or just under 2 balls of recommended yarn.

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

st : stitch

sc : Single crochet

dc: Double Crochet

tr: Triple Crochet

-1dc cluster is 3dcs in the same stitch.

Row 1:



1. Ch 6, and join with a slip stitch to make a ring.



2. Ch 5.



3. Crochet 3 dc into the ring.



4. Ch 3.



5. Crochet 3 dc into the ring.



6. Ch 1 and crochet 1 tr into the ring.

Row 2:



7. Ch 5 and turn the work.



8. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle.



9. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



10. Ch 1. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle.



11. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



12. Ch 3. You will crochet into the same ch-space as before.



13. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



14. Ch 1. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle.



15. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



16. Ch 1. The needle now shows the 4th chain in the previous row.



17. Crochet 1 tr in the 4th chain from the previous row.

Row 3:



18. Ch 5 and turn the work.



19. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle.



20. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



21. Ch 1. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle.



22. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



23. Ch 1. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle



24. Crochet 1 dc cluster, ch 3, 1 dc cluster in the ch-space.



25. Ch 1. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle



26. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



27. Ch 1. The next cluster is made in the ch-space shown by the needle



28. Crochet 1 dc cluster.



29. Ch 1 and crochet 1 tr in the 4th ch from the previous row.

Continue in this pattern for 44 rows or until you reach the desired size of your scarf/shawl.

”Ch 5, *crochet 1 dc cluster in each ch-space, ch 1* until you reach the tip of the scarf.

Crochet 1 dc cluster, ch 3, 1 dc cluster.

ch 1 and 1 dc cluster in each ch-space until you reach the last ch-space.

ch 1 and crochet 1 tr in the 4th chain from the previous row.”
