



Lollipop "Granny" Blanket

No. 1001-171-7519

Materials:

Crochet hook size J/10 (6 mm).
Hobbii Lollipop yarn

Buy the yarn for the pattern here:

Measurements: approx. 66.9 x 51.2 inches (170 x 130 cm).

Usage: approx. 59.5 oz. (1500 g). (7 ½ skeins)

Abbreviations:

ch: chain
s: stitch
sts: stitches
sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet

- The pattern is divisible with 3+1. If you wish to make a larger blanket then you just add a number of chain stitches that are divisible with 3.
 - 1 dc group consists of 3 dc stitches in the same stitch.
1. Start by chaining 172.
 2. In the 2nd ch s from the hook you work 1 sc. Continue with sc till the end of the row.
 3. Turn your work by chaining 3. Skip 2 sts and work now 1 dc group in the next stitch. *Skip 2 sts and work now 1 dc group in the next stitch*. Repeat *to* till the end of the row. The row ends with 1 dc group in the last stitch.
 4. Turn your work by chaining 3. Work dc groups in the interspace between the dc groups of the previous row. Repeat till the end of the row.

Repeat row 4 until you reach the desired length of your blanket.



Instructions:



1. Start by chaining 172.



2. In the 2nd ch s from the hook you work 1 sc. Continue with sc till the end of the row.



3. Turn your work by chaining 3.



4. Skip 2 stitches



5. In the next s, work 1 dc group.



6. Skip 2 stitches.



7. In the next s, work 1 dc group.



8. Repeat till the end of the row. Finish the row with 1 dc group.



9. Turn your work by chaining 3.



10. Work in the interspaces between the dc groups of the previous row.



11. Work 1 dc group in the first interspace.



12. Next dc group is worked in the interspace between the dc groups o the previous row.



13. Work 1 dc group.



14. Repeat till the end of the row. Finish the row with 1 dc group between the interspace of the last dc group and the 3 ch sts of the previous row.
