



## Hat in garter stitch

### Usage, for all sizes

100 g Hobbii Baby Merino XL,  
25 g Mayflower Kid Silk

### Materials

- Hobbii Baby merino XL
- Mayflower Kid Silk
- Single pointed needles size 4 mm / US6
- Stitch markers
- Go Handmade pompon 13 cm

### Gauge

19 st x 40 rows = 10 x 10 cm using 2 strands

### Measurements

Circumference:

47 (50) 54 cm, giver sig 3-5 cm

### Abbreviations

**st:** stitch(es)

**garter st:** knit all rows

**dec:** decrease

**k:** knit

**k2tog:** knit 2 st together

**sl1k:** slip 1 st knitwise: insert tip of right needle in next st on left needle from front to back as if to knit. Slide st off left needle on to right needle.

**ssk tbl:** slip 2 stitches knitwise, one by one from left needle on to right needle. Knit these 2 stitches together through back loop (= yarn over and pull through back loop).

**Pattern** – see photo guide below the pattern:

The hat is worked in two strands: 1 strand baby merino wool and 1 strand kid silk.

The hat is worked bottom up.

CO 91 (96) 101 st on with single point needles size 4 mm / US6 and 2 strands. Work garter st back and forth until piece measures 15 (15) 15 st.

The tip of the hat with dec will measure 8 -10 cm.

Now begin dec in every 4<sup>th</sup> row as follows:

Row 1: k 1, \*ssk tbl, k 16 (17) 18\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire row = 86 (91) 96 st.

Work 3 rows.

If wanted, insert markers at every dec.

Row 5: k 1, \*ssk tbl, k 15 (16) 17\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire row = 81 (86) 91 st.

Work 3 rows.

Row 9: k 1, \*ssk tbl, k 14 (15) 16\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire row = 76 (81) 86 st.

Work 3 rows.

Row 13: k 1, \*ssk tbl, k 13 (14) 15\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire row = 71 (76) 81 st.

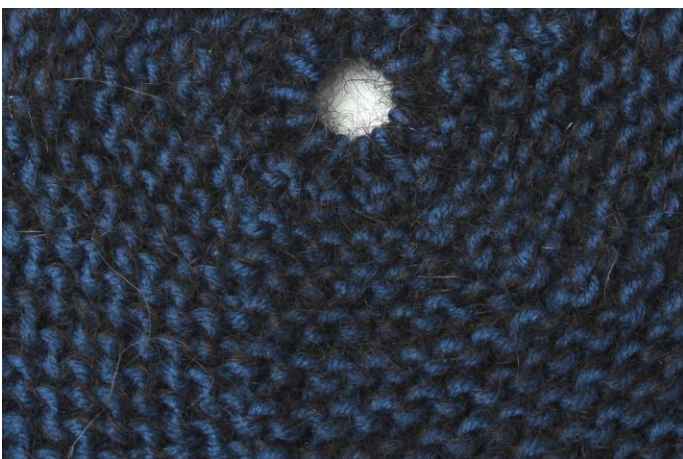
Work 3 rows.

Row 17: k 1, \*ssk tbl, k 12 (13) 14\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire row = 66 (71) 76 st.

Now continue dec in the same way in every 2<sup>nd</sup> row until you have 26 (26) 26 st over.

In next row k2tog 13 times = 13 st.

Break yarn and pull through remaining st, tighten and fasten. Sew the hat together mid back.



## Attaching pom pom:



Sew the snap button from the pom pom on to the top of the hat and attach.

## Instruction – ssk tbl:



1. Slip 1 st knitwise and slip 1 more st knitwise,



2. insert left needle through both slipped st, keeping the left needle in front,



3. knit the 2 st together (= yarn over and pull through back loop).



4. You have a single left-leaning decrease.
