



# **Knit Baby Hat - Cotton**

No. 2004-171-2283

#### **Materials:**

50 (50) 50 g Hobbii Rainbow Knitting needles US 2.5 (3.0 mm)

Pompom- 4 inches

#### Buy yarn and materials here:

**Sizes:** 0-3 (3-6) 6-12 months

**Gauge:** 28 sts x 50 rows =  $4^{\circ}$  x  $4^{\circ}$ 

#### Hat measurement before assembly:

Width of cast on edge: approx. 5 ½ (6) 6 ¼ in.

Length: ca 13 ½ (15) 16 ½ in.

#### **Abbreviations:**

St: stitch

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

**Ssk:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, one at a time, from the left needle to the right needle. Insert the left needle into the fronts of these two slipped stitches and knit them together.

**K2tog:** Insert the right needle from front to back (knitwise) into the next two stitches on the left needle. Wrap the yarn around the right needle (as when knitting) and pull it through.

**M1:** Insert the left needle from back to front into the horizontal strand between the last stitch worked and the next stitch on the left needle. Knit this strand through the back loop to twist the stitch.



Note: There are increases and decreases on the right side of the work (every other row) The stitch count remains the same throughout the work.

#### Pattern:

CO 40 (42) 44 sts. Knit 1 row.

Part 1: - Slants to the left.

Row 1 (RS): K2, ssk, k until there are 2 sts remaining, M1, K2. 40 (42) 44 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 15 (17) 19 ridges = approx.  $2\frac{1}{4}(2\frac{1}{2})$  3 in.

Part 2: - Slants to the right.

Row 1: K2, M1, K until 4 sts remain, K2tog, K2.

Row 2: K all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 15 (17) 19 ridges =  $4 \frac{1}{2}$  (5) 6 in.

Part 3: - Slants to the left.

Row 1: K2, ssk, k until there are 2 sts remaining, M1, K2.

Row 2: K all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 12 (13) 14 ridges =  $6 \frac{1}{2}$  (7  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) 8  $\frac{1}{4}$  in.

Now you've reached the halfway point. You can knit 2 rows without increasing or decreasing until the hat measures approx.  $6 \frac{3}{4} (7 \frac{1}{2}) 8 \frac{1}{4}$  in.





Part 4: - Slants to the right.

Row 1: K2, M1, K until 4 sts remain, K2tog, K2.

Row 2: K all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 12 (13) 14 ridges.

Part 5: - Slants to the left.

Row 1: K2, ssk, k until there are 2 sts remaining, M1, K2.

Row 2: K all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 15 (17) 19 ridges

Part 6: - Slant to the right.

Row 1: K2, M1, K until 4 sts remain, K2tog, K2.


Row 2: K all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 15 (17) 19 ridges

Bind off.

**Ties**: CO 75 sts. Turn and bind off all sts. Pull the end tight and attach to the hat by the points covering the ears.





### Photo Tutorial - Assembly and adding the ties:



1. Sew parts 1 & 2 together, 3 & 4 together, 5 & 6 together.



2. Sew the CO edge and the BO edges together.





3. CO 75 sts. Turn and bind off all sts. Pull the end tight and attach to the hat by the points covering the ears.

## **Photo Tutorial - Pompom**





Sew the snap onto the top of the hat. Attach the pompom to the snap.
