



Ribbon Easter Bread Basket

No. 1001-171-3435

Materials:

- Crochet hook H – L /5-8 mm (depending on your gauge)
- Hobbii Ribbon
- 4” and 3” (10 and 7.5 cm) leather strap $\frac{3}{4}$ ” wide. – natural
- 2 rivets: 6 x 9 mm.
- Leather Punch

Finished Size:

Large: Base 7” (18 cm), Height 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ” (8.5 cm)
Small: Base 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” (12 cm), Height 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” (6.5 cm)

Yarn Requirements: Approx.

Large: 190 g.
Small: 105 g.

Abbreviations:

- st:** stitch
sc: single crochet
long-sc: long single crochet
BL: back loop
Sl st: slip stitch

Gauge: This project can be worked with a H hook (5.0mm) but the size is dependent on how tightly or loosely you crochet.

If the hook is too small the base will begin to curve into a bowl. If this happens, try a larger hook.

Small:

1. Using a magic loop method, work 8 sc in the ring (8)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (16)
3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (24)
4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (32)
5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (40)
6. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (48)
7. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 7 times. Work 1 sc in the last 6 sts. (55)
8. Work 1 sc into the BL of each st to the end of the rnd. (55)
9. Work 1 sc of each st to the end of the rnd. (55)
10. Work " 1 long-sc, 1 sc" Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd, end with a long-sc. (55)
11. Work "1 sc, 1 long-sc" Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd, end with a sc. (55)
Repeat rnds 10 and 11 until you have a total of 8 rnds.
18. End with 1 rnd of sl st. Cut yarn and weave in the ends.

Large:

1. Using a magic loop method, work 8 sc in the ring (8)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (16)
3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (24)
4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (32)
5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (40)
6. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (48)
7. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (56)
8. Work "1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (64)
9. Work "1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 8 times. (72)
10. Work "1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" a total of 7 times. Work 1 sc in the last 9 sts. (79)
11. Work 1 sc into the BL of each st to the end of the rnd. (79)
12. Work 1 sc of each st to the end of the rnd. (79)
13. Work " 1 long-sc, 1 sc" Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd, end with a long-sc. (79)
14. Work "1 sc, 1 long-sc" Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd, end with a sc. (79)
Repeat rnds 13 and 14 until you have a total of 10 rnds.
23. End with 1 rnd of sl st. Cut yarn and weave in the ends.

Photo Tutorial:



1. This is what the base looks like when completed.



2. Work 1 rnd of sc in the BL. The needle indicates where to insert the hook.



3. Like this.



4. Repeat 1 sc in the BL of each st to the end of the rnd.



5. Work 1 rnd of sc.

Sides - Rnd 1:



1. Now you will begin the pattern with alternating sc and long-sc as follows.



2. Work 1 long-sc. This means working a regular sc but into the row below where you would normally work. The needle indicates where to insert the hook.



3. Like this. You now have 1 long-sc.



4. Work 1 regular sc in the next st as you normally would.




5. Work 1 long-sc. The needle indicates where to insert the hook.



6. Like this.



7. Work 1 regular sc in the next st. Work "1 long-sc, 1 sc" to the end of the rnd.



8. End with 1 long-sc. This was the first rnd.

Sides - Rnd 2:



1. On the next rnd work "1 sc, 1 long-sc". Work 1 sc in the first st.



2. Now you are ready to work 1 long-sc. This is worked around the regular sc from the previous rnd. The needle indicates where to insert the hook for the long-sc.



3. Like this.



4. Now work 1 sc in the next st.



5. Work 1 long-sc. This is again worked around the regular sc from the previous rnd. The needle indicates where to insert the hook for the long-sc.



6. Like this.



7. Work "1 sc, 1 long-sc" to the end of the rnd. End with 1 sc. Continue alternating these rows as instructed in the pattern.



8. End with 1 rnd of sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Attaching the leather pieces:



Cut the leather to size (4" and 3") Use the leather working punch tool to make a hole in each end.



Place the leather strap over the edge and attach with a rivet.
