

## Rainbow Baby Blanket

## Materials:

Rainbow cotton 8/4
Crochet hook US size E/4 (3,5 mm)

## Usage:

Color 1-Red 058-1 skein
Color 2-Orange 057-1 skein
Color 3-Sunny Yellow 055-1 skein
Color 4-Yellow 054-1 skein
Color 5-Green 084-1 skein
Color 6-Mint 024-1 skein
Color 7 - Light turquoise 034-1 skein
Color 8 - Blue 031-1 skein
Color 9-Purple 039-1 skein
Color 10-Pink 045-1 skein
Edge - White 001-1 skein

Measurements: Approx. $33 \times 33$ inches
( $84 \times 84 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain
St: Stitch
Sc: Single crochet
Hdc: Half double crochet
Dc: Double crochet
Tog: Together
Yo: Yarn over

The Zig-zag pattern is divisible with $16+1$ st.
Att.: The turn st DOES NOT replace any stitches.
3 dc tog: (yo, get the yarn under the next st, yo, pull the hook through 2 loops on the hook) 3 times ( $=4$ loops on the hook), yo and pull through all loops.

## Pattern: See illustrated instructions at the end of the pattern

Ch 161 with color 1. Turn with ch 2 (all in all ch 163).

## Base row:

1. Work 1 dc in the first 3 ch (work the first in 3 rd ch from the hook). Work " 1 hdc in the next 3 st, 1 sc in the next $5 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$ in the next 3 st and 1 dc in the next 5 st ". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with 1 dc in the last 3 st. Turn with ch 2 .
2. Now repeat the base row: Work 1 dc in the first 3 ch (work the first in 3rd ch from the hook). Work " 1 hdc in the next $3 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next 5 st, 1 hdc in the next 3 st and 1 dc in the next 5 $s t$ ". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with 1 dc in the last 3 st. Switch to color 2 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.

## Continue in pattern rows and stripes like this:

1. Work 2 dc in first st. Work " 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc tog, 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with just 2 dc in last st. Turn with ch 2.
2. Work 2 dc in first st. Work " 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc tog, 1 dc in the next $6 \mathrm{sts}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with just 2 dc in last st. Switch to color 3 in last pullthrough in the last dc. Turn with ch 2 .

Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 4 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 5 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 6 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 7 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 8 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 9 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1st and 2nd pattern row and switch to color 10 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.
Repeat 1 st and 2 nd pattern row and switch to color 1 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.

Repeat these rows until you have 38 stripes all in all. The last stripe is in color 8 and you switch to color 9 in the last pull-through of the last dc.
Turn with ch 1.


## Finishing row:

1. Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts. Work " 1 hdc in the next $3 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next $5 \mathrm{sts}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$ in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 5 sts". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with 1 sc in the last 3 sts. Turn with ch 2.
2. Now repeat the finishing row. Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts. Work " 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 5 sts, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 5 sts". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with 1 sc in the last 3 sts. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

## Edge: See illustrated instructions at the end of the pattern

1 bubble: Yo, get the yarn under the next st, yo, pull the hook through 2 loops on the hook, (yo, get the yarn under the same st, yo, pull the hook through 2 loops on the hook) 2 times ( $=4$ loops on the hook), yo and pull through all loops.

The edge is worked in white
1st round: Start 2 inches ( 5 cm ) before a corner. Work 1 round of sc and finish with 1 sl st.
2nd round: ch 3 . Work " 1 bubble, ch 1 , skip 1 st ". Repeat "to" around. Work $3 x$ " 1 bubble, ch 1 " in the corners. Finish with 1 sl st in 2 nd ch from the beginning of the round.
3rd round: ch 1 and now work sc around and finish with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.


## Instructions: Base row



1. Ch 163. The first st is worked in 3 rd ch from the hook. Here the needle marks the 3rd ch.

2. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 sts.

3. Work 1 dc in the first 3 sts.

4. Work 1 sc in the next 5 sts.

5. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 sts.

6. Repeat " 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 5 sts, 1 hdc in the next $3 \mathrm{sts}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next 5 sts" rest of the row

7. Work 1 dc in the next 5 sts.

8. but finish with 1 dc in the last 3 sts.

9. Turn with ch 2 .

10. Switch to color 2 in the last pull-through.

11. Now repeat the base row: Work 1 dc in the first 3 st. Work " 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 5 sts, 1 hdc in the next $3 \mathrm{sts}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next 5 sts". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with 1 dc in the last 3 sts.

12. Turn with ch 2.


## Instructions: Pattern rows and stripes:



1. Work 2 dc in first st.

2. Work 3 dc tog.

3. Work 3 dc in the same st.

4. Work 1 dc in the next 6 sts.

5. Work 1 dc in the next 6 sts.

6. Repeat and work " 1 dc in the next $6 \mathrm{sts}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ tog, 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st" rest of the row

7. but finish with just 2 dc in the last st.

8. Work 2 dc in the first st.

9. Work 3 dc tog.
10. Turn with ch 2 .


10 . Work 1 dc in the next 6 sts.

12. Work 1 dc in the next 6 sts.

13. Work 3 dc in the same st.

15. but finish with just 2 dc in the last st. Switch to color 3 in the last pull-through in the last dc. Turn with ch 2.

14. Repeat and work " 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc tog, 1 dc in the next $6 \mathrm{sts}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next st" rest of the row

16. Now repeat these pattern rows as described in the pattern.


## Instructions: Finishing rows



1. Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts.

2. Work 1 dc in the next 5 sts.

3. Work 1 sc in the next 5 sts.

4. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 sts.

5. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 sts.

6. Now repeat and work " 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 5 sts, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 5 sts" rest of the row

7. but finish with 1 sc in the last 3 sts.
8. Turn with ch 1 .

9. Now repeat the finishing row. Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts. Work " 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 5 sts, 1 hdc in the next $3 \mathrm{sts}, 1$ sc in the next 5 sts". Repeat "to" rest of the row but finish with 1 sc in the last 3 sts. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.


## Instructions: Edge



1. In white: Work 1 round of sc around the blanket. Work 3 sc in the corners.

2. Ch 3.

3. Ch 1 and skip 1 st.

4. Finish the round with 1 sl st.

5. Work 1 bubble in the first st.

6. Work 1 bubble in the next st.

7. Ch 1 and skip 1 st.

8. Work $3 x$ " 1 bubble, ch 1 " in the corners.

9. Work 1 bubble in the next st.

10. Repeat all around the blanket and finish with 1 sl st in 2 nd ch from the beginning of the round.

11. Ch 1 ch and work 1 sc in all st around. Finish with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
