



Lanyard Keychain – 8/4

Materials:

- Rainbow Cotton 8/4
- Crochet hook B/C (2.5mm)
- Carabiner hook ¼" x 1 ½"

Buy the yarn and materials here:

Size: Approx. 16" long

Yarn Requirements: Approx. 10g

Abbreviations:

ch: chain

st: stitch

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sl st: slip stitch

Pattern – Photo tutorial can be found after the written pattern:

1. Ch 178.
2. Work 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook. Skip 1 st and work 5 hdc in the next st. Skip 1 st and work 1 sc in the next st. *skip 1 st, (5 hdc), skip 1 st, 1sc* Repeat * to * to the end of the row. You now have 44 shells.

Now you will work on the backside of the starting chain. Work 1 sc in the same st that you worked the last sc. *skip 1 st, (5 hdc- in the same space that you worked 5 hdc on the previous side), skip 1 st, 1sc in the same space that you worked 1 sc on the previous side* Repeat * to * to the end of the row. End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Photo Tutorial:



1. Begin with a ch.



2. In the 2nd ch from the hook (where the needle is indicating)



3. Work 1 sc.



4. Skip 1 st.



5. Work 5 hdc in the next st.



6. Skip 1 st,



7. Work 1 sc in the next st



8. * Skip 1 st,



9. (5hdc).



10. Skip 1 st,



11. Work 1 sc in the next st.*



12. Repeat * to * to the end of the row. You now have 44 shells.



13. Now you will work on the backside of the starting chain. Work 1 sc in the same st that you worked the last sc.



14. *skip 1 st, (5 hdc- in the same space that you worked 5 hdc on the previous side),



15. Like this.



16. skip 1 st, 1sc in the same space that you worked 1 sc on the previous side*



17. Like this.



18. Repeat * to * to the end of the row. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Assembly:



1. Lay the ends on top of each other as shown here.



2. Crochet them together with 4 sc.



3. Ch 1 and turn, work 1 row of sc. (5) Repeat once more. Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.



4. Fold the sc section around the keychain on the carabiner and sew it securely in place.



5. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



6. Now your lanyard is ready for use! 😊
