



Sunrise Beach Bag

No. 2003-171-8706

Materials:

3 skeins Cosy, Go Handmade no 17369

Double ended needles size 7

Circular needle size 7, 60 cm

Tension:

19 stitches to 4 inch

30 rows to 4 inch

Pattern

Cast on 8 stitches on needle size 7. Distribute them on the double ended needles or knit using the magic loop technique.

Increases:

1st round: *Yarn over, knit 1*. Repeat from * to * the rest of the round.

2nd round: Knit all stitches. Knit the yarn overs from the back of the loop.

3rd round: *Yarn over, knit 2*. Repeat from * to * the rest of the round.


4th round: Knit all stitches. Knit the yarn overs from the back of the loop.

5th round: *Yarn over, knit 3*. Repeat from * to * the rest of the round.

Repeat the increases 16 times = 128 stitches.

Only increase twice on this last round to give you a total of 130 stitches.

Knit according to the diagram until your work measures approx. 13,7 inch. Make sure you finish with the 6th or 12th round so the diagram ends the same way it started.



Stocking stitch 5 rounds.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Handle:

Knit two 29.5 inch I-cord handles by picking up 5 stitches of the edge of the bag with a double ended needle.



Push the stitches to the other end of the knitting needle so your yarn tail is at the “wrong” side of the stitches.



Knit on as normal. Make sure to tighten the first stitch.



Repeat until your work has the right length. The first stitch ensures that your work becomes round.

Sew them onto the edge.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
