

## Winter Happiness Shawl

## Materials:

- Cotton Kings Sultan Deluxe- 1 skein
- Kid silk eller super kid silk- 5 skeins
- Crochet Hook h (5.0mm)

Finished Size: Approx. 198 x 85 cm

## Gauge:

15 sts x $8 ½$ rows $=4$ " $\times 4$ "

Abbreviations:
Ch: Chain
St: stitch
sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet
tr: treble crochet
ch-space: chain space

## There is a photo tutorial following the written pattern.

## Pattern:

Note: This shawl is worked by holding one strand of Sultan Deluxe and 1 strand of Kid silk together.
Ch 4 and join in a ring with a sl st.

1. Ch 4 (counts as 1 tr ). Work 4 dc , ch $2,4 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the ring.
2. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr). Work 2 dc in the first st. Work 1 dc in the next 4 sts. In the ch-space, work 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 4 sts. In the last st, work 2 dc and 1 tr.
3. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr ). Work 2 dc in the first st. *skip $1 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next st* Repeat *_* a total of 4 times. In the ch-space, work 2 dc ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$. Work * 2 dc in the next st, skip 1 st*$^{*}$. Repeat*_* a total of 4 times. In the last st, work 2 dc and 1 tr .
4. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr). Work 2 dc in the first st. *Work 2 dc in the space between the 2 dc on the previous row* Repeat *_* a total of 6 times. In the ch-space, work 2 dc, ch 2,2 dc. *Work 2 dc in the space between the 2 dc on the previous row* Repeat *_* a total of 6 times. In the last st, work 2 dc and 1 tr .
5. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr ). Work 2 dc in the first st. *Work 2 dc in the space between the 2 dc on the previous row* Repeat *_* a total of 8 times. In the ch-space, work 2 dc, ch 2,2 dc. *Work 2 dc in the space between the 2 dc on the previous row* Repeat *_* a total of 8 times. In the last st, work 2 dc and 1 tr .

Repeat row 5 for a total of 49 times.


## Ending Row:

Ch 1 . Sc in all sts across. In the ch-space, work 2 sc. Cut yarn and tie off. Weave in ends.


## Photo Tutorial:

Note: Photo tutorial is shown using only a single strand.
Row. 1


1. Ch 4 (counts as 1 tr). Work 4 dc , ch $2,4 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ tr in the ring.

## Row 2



1. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr). Work 2 dc in the first st where the needle is pointing.

2. Like this.

3. Work 1 dc in the next 4 sts.

4. Work 1 dc in the next 4 sts.

5. In the ch-space, work 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$.

6. In the last st- where the needle is pointing,

7. Work 2 dc and 1 tr.

## Row 3



1. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr). Work 2 dc in the first st.

2. Repeat *-* a total of 4 times.

3. *skip 1 st, 2 dc in the next st*

4. In the ch-space, work 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$.

5. *2 dc in the next st, skip 1 st* 2 dc in the first st. *Work 2 dc in the space between the 2 dc on the previous row* The needle is pointing to the space where the dcs are to be worked.

6. Repeat *-* a total of 4 times.
7. In the last st, work 2 dc and 1 tr .

## Row 4



1. Ch 4 and turn the work (counts as 1 tr). Work

2. Repeat *-* a total of 6 times.

3. In the ch-space, work $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$.

## Row 5



This row is worked the same way as row 4, but with 8 repeats of *-* instead of 6 .

4. *Work 2 dc in the space between the 2 dc on the previous row* Repeat *-* a total of 6 times. In the last st, work 2 dc and 1 tr.

Row 6 and on


1. Repeat row 5 for a total of 49 times. End with a row of sc..
