



# **Alice - Winter set**

## In two-colored fisherman's rib

No. 2004-184-4711

#### Materials

3 skeins of 4 oz (100 g) Woolpower, color no. 3, one-colored (A) 3 skeins of 4 oz (100 g) Woolpower Color no. 101, multi-colored (B)

Double pointed needles and circular needle 31.5" (80 cm), 0.3" (6 mm)

## **Knitting Gauge**

Fisherman's rib: 14 stitches x 36 rows =  $4 \times 4$  inches (10 x 10 cm)

Stockinette: 16 stitches x 22 rounds =  $4 \times 4$  inches (10 x 10 cm)

### Measurements

Scarf: approx. 8 x 85 inches (20 x 215 cm) Hat: 18 (20) 22 inches (45 (50) 55 cm) in circumference, it will stretch

**Abbreviations** 

st: stitch r: row

tog: together
rnd: round

edge stitch: 1 slip stitch purlwise with

yarn in front of the work

1 slip stitch purlwise: insert your right needle in the stitch from right to left

yon: yarn over needle

yarn over: place the yarn over the right

needle = yarn over needle /yon

#### Abbreviations in fisherman's rib:

**Knit 1=** work yon and the stitch (that is on top of each other) together knitwise into 1 stitch.

**Purl 1**= work yon and the stitch (that is on top of each other) together purlwise into 1 stitch



#### Two-colored fisherman's rib

Knit back and forth in the round.

Main needle: (cast on, 1 slip stitch purlwise, k1)

The first stitch is an edge stitch and the last stitch is a knit stitch.

Turn or move the work to the opposite needle tip where the other yarn color is.

Work alternately 1 round of each color.

Alternately, work 2 rounds together knitwise and 2 rounds together purlwise.

#### **PATTERN - SCARF**

Cast on 34 stitches in color A on the circular needle, and work back and forth.

Change to color B and work the main round: k1, (yon, 1 slip stitch purlwise, k1) until you have 1 st left, k1.

#### Continue in two-colored fisherman's rib:

- **1. row:** Color A, 1 edge stitch, (yon, work 1 slip stitch purlwise, work st/yon purlwise tog) until you have 1 st left, k1.
- 2. row: Color B, 1 edge stitch, (yon, work 1 slip stitch purlwise, work st/yon tog) until you have 1 st left, k1.
- **3. row:** Color A, 1 edge stitch, (work st/yon knitwise tog, yon, work 1 slip stitch purlwise) until you have 1 st left, k1.
- **4. row:** Color B, 1 edge stitch, (work st/yon knitwise tog, yon, work 1 slip stitch purlwise) until you have 1 st left, k1.

#### Repeat these 4 rows.

Work straight until you are almost out of yarn, approx. 85 inches (215 cm). Bind off in rib.





#### **PATTERN - HAT**

The hat is worked in the round, top down in stockinette stitch. The ribbed edge is also worked in the round, but in two-colored fisherman's rib.

Cast on 8 stitches with color A. Divide the stitches on 4 needles (or knit magic loop on circular needle) and work in the round.

Start increases.

- 1. Round: \*k1, make 1 st\*. Repeat \*-\* till the end of the round = make 8 stitches = 16 stitches.
- 2. Round: Knit all stitches.
- 3. Round: \*yon, knit 2\*. Repeat \*-\* till the end of the round = 24 stitches.
- 4. Round: knit all stitches.
- 5. Round: \*yon, k 3\*. Repeat \*-\* till the end of the round = 32 stitches.
- 6. Round: Knit all stitches.

Continue like this until you have increased 8 (9) 10 times = 72 (80) 88 stitches on the round.

Continue in the round in stockinette stitch until your work measures: 6.7, 7.1, 7.5 inches (17 (18) 19 cm) in diameter.

Decrease like this in the next round:

Size small: work \*k7, k2tog\*. Repeat \*-\* till the end of the round = 64 stitches.

Size m: work \*k8, k2tog\*. Repeat \*-\* till the end of the round = 70 stitches.

Size L: work \*k8, k2tog\*. Repeat \*-\* 10 times, work till the end of the round = 78 stitches.

Continue with the two-colored fisherman's rib in the edge.

#### Edge

The edge is worked in fisherman's rib with the wrong side outward, so the one-colored yarn is the most visible on "the right side" when the edge is folded.

Work the first main round in fisherman's rib like this:

Color A, \*yon, 1 slip stitch purlwise, k1\*. Repeat \*-\* till the end of the round.

#### Two-colored fisherman's rib:

- 1. Round: color A, \*p1, yon, 1 slip stitch purlwise\*. Repeat till the end of the round.
- 2. Round: color B, \*yon, 1 slip stitch purlwise, k1\*. Repeat till the end of the round.

Repeat these 2 rounds until the edge measures 4-5 inches (10-12 cm)

Bind off in rib in color A.
