



# Oslo - Knit Basket

No. 2004-184-6697

### **Materials**

2 skeins of 100 g Woolpower color 10 DPN and 32" Circular needles US 11 (8 mm)

#### Measurements

Before Felting:

Width- measured flat: 21 inches
From starting point to top: 15 inches

Height of the side: 7 ½ inches

After Felting:

Width- measured flat: 13 inches Height of the side: 4 ¼ inches

# Gauge

14 sts x 12 rows = 4" x 4"

#### Pattern information

The bottom of the basket is knit on DPNs and switches to the circular needles once there are enough sts.

It is knit in the round in garter stitch = knit 1 round, purl 1 round.

Wash in a machine on hot cycle in order to felt.

#### Abbreviation of increase stitch

**M1:** From the front, lift loop between stitches with left needle, knit into back of loop.



#### **Starting Square**

Begin by creating a small square as follows:

CO 3 sts and knit 6 rows.

After the 6<sup>th</sup> row, do not turn, pick up 3 sts on a new DPN along the left side. = 6 sts

Do not turn, pick up 3 sts on a new DPN on the left side = 9 sts.

Do not turn, pick up 3 sts on a new DPN on the left side = 12 sts.

Place a marker at the beginning of the round.

#### Knit the base in garter stitch in the round as follows:

Round 1 (WS): Purl all sts.

Round 2 (RS): (k2, m1) repeat across all sts = 6 sts increased = 18 sts.

Round 3 and all WS rounds: Purl all sts.

Round 4 (RS): (k3, m1) repeat across all sts = 6 sts increased = 24 sts.

Continue in this manner with 1 more sts between increases on each RS round until there are 144 sts.

Place a marker to show the beginning round of the sides.

#### Sides of the basket

Knit in garter st evenly until the sides measure 7  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches from the last increasing round. Bind off.


Wash in a machine on hot cycle to felt.

Basket before washing




Basket after washing




# Photo Tutorial - Starting Square




1. CO 3 sts and knit 6 rows.



2. Do not turn, pick up 3 sts on a new DPN on the left side = 6 sts



3. Do not turn, pick up 3 sts on a new DPN on the left side = 9 sts



4. Do not turn, pick up 3 sts on a new DPN on the left side = 12 sts.

#### Photo tutorial - m1



1. From the front, lift loop between stitches with left needle



2. knit into back of loop
