

## Felted Christmas Tree

## Skirt

No. 2003-184-1216

## Materials

60" Circular needle US 11 ( 8 mm ) DPN US 11 ( 8 mm ) to start with Crochet Hook I ( 5.5 mm )

6 skeins of 100 g Woolpower color 9
2 skein of 100 g Woolpower color 16
2 skein of 100 g Woolpower color 18

## Measurements

Before Felting: Approx. 75 " in diameter
After Felting: Approx. 32" in diameter

Gauge
12 sts $=4$ "
20 rnds = 4"

## Pattern

## Starting from a square

CO 4 sts on DPNs and knit 8 rows in stockinette (knit 1 row purl 1 row).
Do not turn, but pick up 4 sts with another DPN along the left side $=8$ sts.
Do not turn, but pick up 4 sts with another DPN along the left side $==12$ sts.
Do not turn, but pick up 4 sts with another DPN along the left side $==16$ sts.
Place a marker to indicate the beginning of the round.

## Knit in stockinette as follows:

Rnd 1: knit all sts.
Rnd 2: (k2, YO) repeat to the end of the rnd = 8 sts increased = 24 sts.
Rnd 3: knit all sts and YOs.
Rnd 4: $(k 3, Y O)$ repeat to the end of the rnd $=8$ sts increased $=32$ sts.
Rnd 5: knit all sts and YOs.
Rnd 6: $(\mathrm{k} 4, \mathrm{YO})$ repeat to the end of the rnd $=8$ sts increased $=40$ sts.

Continue in this manner until the piece measures $271 / 2$ in. from the center.

The stripes are knit on the last 12 ". Each stripe is 10 rnds. Continue to increase as before while working the stripes.

Color order of stripes:

- Green
- Red
- Gray
- Green
- Red

Bind off and weave in ends.
Crochet around the edge with single crochet so the edge does not roll as much.
Wash the tree skirt on a warm cycle to felt.
Pull into shape while it is still damp. Lay flat to dry.
