

## Winter Wool Wrap - Short

## Materials:

- Crochet hook size 8 mm / US L/11
- Happy Sheep Woolpower

## Abbreviations:

Ch: chain stitch
St: stitch(es)
Dc: double crochet
Sl st: slip stitch

Gauge: 10 st $\times 5,5$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

Size: One size (please read information about the size on the next page).
Measurements: Approx. 36 cm in height x 100 cm circumference. (Measured flat and piece can widen up to $10-12 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Usage: Approx. 200g (2 balls)

Information about the size:
This pattern is a one size pattern, but you can easily adapt it to an individual person or size.
Begin with working ch stitches and measure where widest around the shoulders. Please note that you need to measure a bit tight as the piece tend to widen a bit. Now follow the instruction of the pattern using the number of stitches you worked for you size (:)

## Möbius technique:

We have used the "Möbius" technique to make the "twist" in this pattern. Möbius is an old technique where you make a twisted circle while working in the round. The technique is explained in the pattern.

## Pattern:

1. Ch 100 on hook size $8 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} \mathrm{L} / 11$ and form a ring with 1 sl st in first ch. Ch 1 and work 1 dc in every ch on entire round.


Normally you would finish a round with 1 sl st in first st. But you don't do that just yet. Instead you fold the beginning of the round down as shown on the photo's below.


Now work dc's in every stitch on both sides of the ch-row on entire round. Finish every round with 1 sl st in first dc. When you worked both sides of your ch-row you have a total of 200 st on entire round and you have made a "twist" in the piece.


2. Ch 1 and work 1 dc in every st on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st in first dc. (200)

Repeat round 2 until you have worked a total of 10 rounds (10 rounds on each side of the ch-row) Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
