Materials

1 skein of 50 g Rainbow Organic Cotton

Or Rainbow 8/4 color 59

Knitting Needles US 2 (2.75 mm)

Clasp with hearts

Sewing needle for assembly

Width approx. 4 ¾ in.

28 sts = 4"

Difficulty level

Pattern information

The purse is made in 2 identical pieces. Increases are always made in the middle of the piece, but on different sides to create the purse. To assemble, the pieces are first attached to the clasp and then sewn together.



Pattern

CO 7 sts.

Begin increasing on both sides and in the middle:

Row 1 (WS): p1, YO, p2, YO, p1, YO, p2, YO, p1 = 11 sts.

Row 2 (RS): k1, k1tbl, k2, k1tbl, k1, k1tbl, k2, k1tbl, k1 = 11 sts.

Row 3 (WS): p1, YO, p4, YO, p1, YO, p4, YO, p1 = 15 sts.

Row 4 (RS): k1, k1tbl, k4, k1tbl, k1, k1tbl, k4, k1tbl, k1 = 15 sts.

Row 5 (WS): p1, YO, p6, YO, p1, YO, p6, YO, p1 = 19 sts.

Row 6 (RS): k1, k1tbl, k6, k1tbl, k1, k1tbl, k6, k1tbl, k1 = 19 sts.

Continue in this manner until there are 43 sts, end with a RS row.

Continue only increasing in the middle:

Row 1 (WS): p to the increase in the middle as before = 2 sts increased.

Row 2 (RS): Knit across, working the YOs through the back loop.

Repeat these 2 rows 6 times = 55 sts.

Continue with decreasing on the sides and increasing in the middle:

Row 1 (WS): p to the increase in the middle as before = 2 sts increased.

Row 2 (RS): k1, k2tog tbl, k to the last 3 sts working the YOs tbl, k2tog tbl, k1 = 2 sts decreased.

Repeat these 2 rows 6 times = 55 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Begin decreasing for the base:

Row 1 (RS): k2tog, repeat to the increased sts in the middle, k3tog, k2tog to the end of the row.

Bind off in purl on the WS.

Make a second piece to match.

Assembly

Sew the pieces to the clasp, starting with the middle sts at the middle of the clasp.

Sew the side and bottom seams of the piece together until $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the clasp on either side.
