



Glacier - Hat

Materials 32" Cicular Needles US 6 (4 mm) Difficulty level

Beginner

1 (1) 1 skein of 50 g Highland Wool color 14

Sizes

S (M) L

Finished Measurements

Diameter when slightly stretched 14 (15 $\frac{3}{4}$) 17 $\frac{1}{4}$ in (36 (40) 44 cm)

Fit Head size: 21 (22) 23 in (54 (56) 58 cm)

Gauge

24 sts per 4" slightly stretched in rib.26 rnds per 4".

Pattern information

The hat is knit from the bottom edge on circular needles using the magic loop technique.

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Hat CO 88 (96) 104 sts.

Work 7 (7 ¹/₂) 7 ³/₄ inches (18 (19) 20 cm) in rib pattern *p2, k2 *.

Decreasing for the top

Place a marker after every 8 sts from the beginning of the rnd. Decrease on every other rnd.

- 1. Rnd 1: *p2tog, k2, p2, k2 * repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
- 2. Rnd 2: work in established pattern.
- 3. Rnd 3: *p1, k2, p2tog, k2* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
- 4. Rnd 4: work in established pattern.
- 5. Rnd 5 : *p1, k2tog, p1, k2* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
- 6. Rnd 6: work in established pattern.
- 7. Rnd 7: *p1, k1, p1, k2tog * repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
- 8. Rnd 8: work in established pattern.
- 9. Rnd 9: k2tog to the end of the rnd.
- 10. Rnd 10: k all sts.
- 11. Rnd 11: k2tog to the end of the rnd.

Cut yarn and pull the end through the remaining sts. Pull tight to close the hole and weave in the ends.
