Materials

1 50g skein Highland Wool no. 15

Needles size 8 (5 mm)

Measurements Length approx. 20 in Width approx. 1 in

Difficulty level Beginner

Pattern notes

You'll knit the headband in shifted rib using double thread.



Headband

Using double thread cast on 16 stitches.

On every row slip the first stitch loosely = edging stitch.

1st row: Slip 1 stitch loosely, *knit 2, purl 2*, repeat from * to * the remainder of the row, finish with knit 1.

2nd row: Slip 1 stitch loosely, *purl 2, knit 2*, repeat from * to * the remainder of the row, finish with knit 1.

Knit rows 1 and 2 a total of 8 times = 1st sequence.

Then knit:

1st row: Slip 1 stitch loosely, *purl 2, knit 2*, repeat from * to * the remainder of the row, finish with knit 1.

2d row: Slip 1 stitch loosely, *knit 2, purl 2*, repeat from * to * the remainder of the row, finish with knit 1.

Knit rows 1 and 2 a total of 8 times = 2nd sequence.

Repeat these 16 rows until your work measures approx. 20 inches and you've knitted 14 sequences.

Cast off.

Sew together the cast on and cast off edge.
