



Greenland Blanket

No. 2004-191-2960

Materials

10 skeins of 100 g Dream Colour, Wintergreen color 08

47" Circular needle US 4 (3.5 mm)

Gauge

Measured in pattern, after being washed 26 sts per 4 in. (10 cm) 42 rows per 4 in. (10 cm) Stretches slightly in length after being washed

Measurements, after washing Width: approx. 63 in. (160 cm) Length: approx. 60 in. (150 cm)

Difficulty level Easy, but with a lot of sts

Pattern information

The blanket is knit flat of circular needles.

The pattern is made of 16 knit sts and 16 purl sts, repeated across the row

The finished blanket weighs approx. 2 lbs, so it is quite large and heavy towards the end of the project – but the results are worth it!



Pattern

CO 420 sts and work in pattern, working flat on the circular needle.

Edge sts: Slip 2 sts as if to purl, with the yarn in front of the work and end with 2 knit sts.

The edge sts are not included in the pattern.

Pattern

Row 1: *k16, p16*, repeat *-* to the end of the row.

Rows 2 and 3: *knit the k sts and purl the p sts *, repeat *-* to the end of the row.

Row 4: *p16, k16 *, repeat *-* to the end of the row.

Rows 5 and 6: * purl the p sts and knit the k sts*, repeat *-* to the end of the row.

Repeat these 6 rows until there is only enough yarn remaining for 3 rows in pattern and bind off.

Wash the blanket and lay flat to dry, blocking into shape and size.
