



## Easter Bunnies - Large

### Materials:

- Crochet hook 2.5 mm
- Rainbow Cotton 8/4
- 1 pair of safety eyes 8 mm
- 4 wooden beads 15 mm
- Toy stuffing
- Plastic granules

**Measurement:** Ca. 17 cm tall (incl. ears)

**Amount of yarn used.:** Per set:

**Brown:** 60g

**A bit of pink and purple**

### Abbreviations:

**ch:** chain

**st:** stitch

**mr:** magic ring

**sc:** single crochet

**sl st:** slip stitch

**BLO:** back loops only

**tog:** together

**hdc:** half double crochet

## **Body:**

With brown

1. Make a magic ring, and work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. 2 sc in each st to the end of the round (12)
3. \*1 sc, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (18)
4. \*1 sc in the next 2 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (24)
5. \*1 sc in the next 3 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (30)
6. \*1 sc in the next 4 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (36)
7. \*1 sc in the next 5 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (42)
8. This round, crochet in BLO. \*1 sc in the next 6 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (48)
9. \*1 sc in the next 7 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (54)
10. – 14. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round (54)
15. \*1 sc in the next 7 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (48)
16. -20. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round (48)
21. \*1 sc in the next 6 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (42)
22. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round (42)
23. \*1 sc in the next 5 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (36)
24. \*1 sc in the next 4 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (30)
25. \*1 sc in the next 3 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (24)
26. \*1 sc in the next 2 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (18)

Do not finish, as we will continue from here.



Put some plastic granules at the bottom and fill the rest of the body with toy stuffing.

## **Head:**

1. 2 sc in each st to the end of the round (36)
2. \*1 sc in the next 5 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (42)
3. \*1 sc in the next 6 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (48)
4. \*1 sc in the next 7 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (54)
5. \*1 sc in the next 8 st, 2 sc in the next st\* Repeat to the end of the round (60)
6. -10. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round (60)
11. \*1 sc in the next 8 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (54)
12. \*1 sc in the next 7 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (48)
13. \*1 sc in the next 6 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (42)
14. \*1 sc in the next 5 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (36) – Now place the eyes between rounds 9 & 10 with 6-7 stitches in between.
15. \*1 sc in the next 4 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (30)
16. \*1 sc in the next 3 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (24) Stuff the head tightly before closing off the hole.
17. \*1 sc in the next 2 st, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (18)
18. \*1 sc, 2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (12)
19. \*2 sc tog\* Repeat to the end of the round (6)

Sew the hole closed.



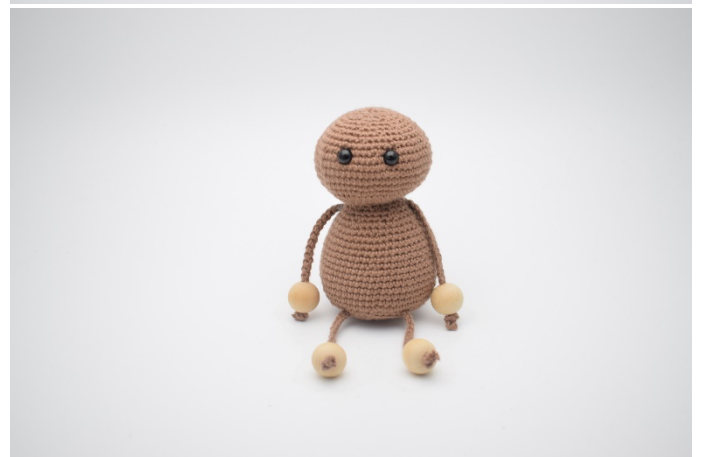
### **Legs and arms:**

With the brown yarn, make 2.

Ch60, 1 sl st in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, sl st throughout the rest of the row.



Pull one end of one chain row through round 9 on the body, and the other chain row end in the same round but with 10-11 stitches in between. Slide the wooden beads on and tie a knot on each end. Pull the other chain row through under the head, place the beads on and tie a knot on each end.



## Indents - Eyes:

Make indentations by the eyes using the following method:



1. With brown yarn, pull the needles out on one side of one of the eyes.



2. Push the needle down on the other side of the eye and pull it tightly.



3. Push the needle up by the side of the other eye.



4. And down again through the other side of the eye.



5. Pull the thread slightly so the eyes are pulled in and small indents are made.

## Ears:

With brown – Make 2.

1. Make a mr and work 6 sc into the ring. (6)
2. 2 sc in each st to the end of the round. (12)
3. \*1 sc in the first st, 2 sc in the next\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (18)
4. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (18)
5. \*1 sc in the first 2 st, 2 sc in the next\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (24)
6. \*1 sc in the first 7 st, 2 sc in the next st\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (27)
7. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (27)
8. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (27)
9. \*1 sc in the first 7 st, 2 sc tog\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (24)
10. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (24)
11. \*1 sc in the first 6 st, 2 sc tog\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (21)
12. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (21)
13. \*1 sc in the first 5 st, 2 sc tog\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (18)
14. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (18)
15. \*1 sc in the first 4 st, 2 sc tog\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (15)
16. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (15)
17. \*1 sc in the first 3 st, 2 sc tog\*. Repeat to the end of the round. (12)
18. -20. 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (12)

Close the ears with sc and leave a long thread for assembly.

Sew the ears onto the head and embroider a nose with pink.



**Bow:**

Ch20, gather into a ring with 1 sl st.

Ch1, hdc to the end of the round, 1 sl st.

Ch1, hdc to the end of the round, 1 sl st.

Ch1, hdc to the end of the round, 1 sl st. Leave a long thread for assembly.

Wind the thread a few times around the middle of the piece you have just crocheted, to form a bow.

Sew the bow on in front of the ear of the bunny.
