



Sky Shawl

Materials

4 skeins of 1.76 oz. (50 g) Aurora col 03

Circular needle size 11 (8 mm)

Crochet hook for attaching tassels

Knitting Gauge

11 stitches on 4" (10 cm)

Measurements without tassels

Width: approx. 47.2 inches / 120 cm

Length: approx. 27.6 inches / 70 cm

Pattern information

The shawl is knitted in the round on circular needle in garter stitch.

The shawl is knitted from the tip and up. You knit an edge stitch and an increase at the beginning of every round, so a lace edge is created.

At the end, you knit a lace round before casting off loosely.

Lastly, you attach the tassels to the oblique sides of the shawl.

Pattern

Cast on 3 stitches and work 1 round knitwise.

Knit edge stitch and lace edge like this:

Slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front of your work, yarn over, work the round knitwise = 1 increase.

Next round: Slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front of your work, yarn over, work the rest of the round knitwise, the yarn over is worked knitwise

Repeat this round until your work measures approx. 27.6 inches (70 cm)

Lace round: Slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front of your work, yarn over, knit 1, *yarn over, knit 2 together knitwise*, repeat from *-* till the end of the round.

Bind off loosely in knit stitches (please keep the knitting gauge in mind)

Tassels

Cut the yarn in lengths of approx. 9.84 inches (25 cm).

Grab 2 threads, fold them on the middle, insert the crochet hook through the hole in the edge, place the tassel on the hook and pull back through the hole approx. 1.2-1.6 inches (2-4 cm), place the yarn over the hook and pull the entire tassel through the loop, pull until the tassel is firmly attached.

Divide the tassels on the two oblique sides of the shawl.
