## Materials:

- Rainbow 8/4 - Double Strand - 3 colors
- Crochet Hook G (4.0mm)
- Go Handmade handbag handles 44 cm
- Go Handmade PU flap $11 \times 18 \mathrm{~mm}$

Yarn Requirements: Approx.
Color A: 130g (3 skeins)
Color B: 80 g ( 2 skeins)
Color C: 80g (2 skeins)

Finished Size: Approx 15" / 38 cm tall and $171 / 4^{\prime \prime} / 44 \mathrm{~cm}$ wide (Measured flat)

## Abbreviations:

ch: chain
st: stitch
sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet
sl st: slip stitch
tog: work 2 sts together (decrease)

## Base:

1. With Color A. Begin with a magic ring. Ch 5 . Work *3dc, ch $3^{*}$ Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. Work 2 dc . End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.
2. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 3 sts, ( 2 dc , ch 2, 2 dc ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times.
Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch..
3. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work * 1 dc in the next 7 sts , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 7 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch .
4. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 11 sts , $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 11 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch .
5. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 15 sts, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times.
Work 1 dc in the next 15 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch .
6. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 19 sts, ( 2 dc , ch 2, 2 dc ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 19 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.
7. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work * 1 dc in the next 23 sts, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 23 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.
8. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 27 sts, ( 2 dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times.
Work 1 dc in the next 27 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch .
9. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 31 sts, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 31 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.
10. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 35 sts, ( 2 dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 35 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st
in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.
11. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work * 1 dc in the next 39 sts , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 39 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.
Cut the yarn.
12. Attach Color B in a ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 43 sts, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 43 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.
13. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 47 sts, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 47 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch..
14. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work *1 dc in the next 51 sts, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times. Work 1 dc in the next 51 sts and 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.
Cut the yarn.

## Begin the sides:

15. Attach Color C in a ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work ${ }^{*} 1$ dc in the next 26 sts, skip 3 sts and work 1 dc in the next 26 sts. Work ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to *a total of 3 times.
Work 1 dc in the next 26 sts, skip 3 sts and work 1 dc in the last 26 sts. Work 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.
16. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.
/Work 1 dc in the first st. *Skip 1 st and work 1 dc. Work 1 dc in the skipped-st. Work 1 dc in the next st. ${ }^{*}$ Repeat * to * 8 times. Dc2tog. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog.
Work 1 dc in the next st. *Skip 1 st and work 1 dc. Work 1 dc in the skipped-st. Work 1 dc in the next st.* Repeat * to * 8 times. ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the ch-space./ Repeat /to/ to total of 3 times.

Work 1 dc in the first st. *Skip 1 st and work 1 dc . Work 1 dc in the skipped-st. Work 1 dc in the next st.* Repeat * to * 8 times. Dc2tog. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog.
Work 1 dc in the next st. *Skip 1 st and work 1 dc . Work 1 dc in the skipped-st. Work 1 dc in the next st.* Repeat * to * 8 times. Work 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch .
17. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work ${ }^{*} 1$ dc in the next 25 sts, dc2tog. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog. Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts. Work ( 2 dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times.

Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts, dc2tog. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog. Work 1 dc in the last 25 sts. Work 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch. Cut the yarn.
18. Attach Color A in a ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

Work ${ }^{*} 1$ dc in the next 25 sts, dc2tog. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog. Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts. Work ( 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in the next ch-space* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times.

Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts, dc2tog. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog. Work 1 dc in the last 25 sts. Work 1 dc in the ch-space from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch .

Repeat Rnds 16-18 until you have a total of 13 rnds on the sides. Work 3 rnds with each color.

## Finishing Rnd:

Ch 1, work sc in each st to the end of the rnd. For the points, work 3 sc in the ch-spaces. End with a sl st. Finally, work 1 rnd of sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Attach the handbag handles with carabiners in the 4 "points" Sew the PU Flap securely to the middle of the bag's opening.

## Photo Tutorial:

## Rnd 1



1. With Color A. Begin with a magic ring. Ch 5.

2. Work *3dc, ch 3*

3. Repeat * to * a total of 3 times.

## Rnd 2



1. Sl st in the ch-space.

2. Work *1 dc in the next 3 sts, (2dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in the next ch-space.*

3. Work 2 dc . End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.

4. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

5. Repeat * to *a total of 3 times.

6. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts and 1 dc in the chspace from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.

## Rnd 3



1. Sl st in the ch-space.

2. Work *1 dc in the next 7 sts, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the next ch-space.*

3. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

4. Repeat * to *a total of 3 times.

5. Work 1 dc in the next 7 sts and 1 dc in the chspace from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.

Rnds 4-11


1. Continue in this manner until you have a total of 11 rnds. Cut the yarn.

Rnd 12


1. Attach Color B in a ch-space.

2. Continue in the same manner as previous rnds.


Rnds 13-14


1. Repeat this 2 more times so that you have a total of 14 rnds for the base. Cut the yarn.

## Rnd 15



1. Attach Color C in a ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

2. skip 3 sts,

3. Work * 1 dc in the next 26 sts.

4. and work 1 dc in the next 26 sts.

5. Work (2dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in the next ch-space.*

## Rnd 16



1. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

2. Skip 1 st and work 1 dc in the next st.

3. Repeat on all 4 sides. Work 1 dc in the chspace from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.

4. Work 1 dc in the first st.

5. Like this.

6. Work 1 dc in the skipped-st.

7. Work 1 dc in the next st.

8. Dc2tog

9. Like this. Now you have made 1 "crossed st".

10. *Skip 1 st and work 1 dc. Work 1 dc in the skipped-st. Work 1 dc in the next st.* Repeat * to * 8 times.

11. Skip 2 sts.


12. Dc2tog

13. Skip 1 st and work 1 dc. Work 1 dc in the skipped-st.

14. Skip 1 st and work 1 dc . Work 1 dc in the skipped-st. Work 1 dc in the next st.* Repeat * to * 8 times.

15. Work 1 dc in the next st.

16. Work 1 dc in the next st.

17. ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in the ch-space.

18. Repeat on all 4 sides. Work 1 dc in the chspace from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch.

Rnd 17


1. Sl st in the ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

2. dc2tog.
3. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog.

4. Like this.

5. Work (2dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in the next ch-space.


6 . Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts.
8. Repeat on all 4 sides. Work 1 dc in the chspace from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the starting ch. Cut the yarn.

2 . Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts.


1. Attach Color A in a ch-space. Ch 4 . Work 2 dc in the same ch-space.

2. dc2tog.

3. Like this.

4. Work (2dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in the next ch-space.

5. Skip 2 sts and dc2tog.


6 . Work 1 dc in the next 25 sts.

8. Repeat on all 4 sides. Work 1 dc in the chspace from the beginning of the rnd. End with a sl st in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$ of the starting ch.

9. Now work 1 rnd with crossed sts pattern and 2 rnds with regular dc.

Rnd 19-27


Repeat Rnds 16-18 until you have a total of 13 rnds on the sides. Work 3 rnds with each color.

## Finishing Rnds



1. Ch 1, work sc in each st to the end of the rnd. For the points, work 3 sc in the ch-spaces. End with a sl st.

2. Work 1 rnd of sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.


Your bag is now ready to attach the accessories.

## Assembly

Attach the handbag handles with carabiners in the 4 "points"


Sew the opposite piece on the opposite side of the bag.

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Sew the PU Flap securely to the middle of the bag's opening.
 bag's opening.


The bag can now be closed with the flap.
