



Sunny Days Hat

Sizes: One Size

Skill level: Beginner

Crochet hook: 4.5 mm (size 7)

Materials: Needle, scissor

Yarn: 2 skeins Hobbii Summer Merino
in color: Curry (05)

Final measurements:

Diameter of dome = 17 cm

Diameter of outer rim = 37 cm

Abbreviations used in this pattern:

- **ch** = chain
- **sc** = single crochet
- **sl st** = slip stitch
- **st(s)** = stitch (es)
- **Inc** = increase (2 dc in the same st)

Gauge

- **16 sc** = 10 cm (4")
- **16 rows** = 10 cm (4")

About the Design

The weather is getting warmer and I'm already thinking of summer. So I just had to make a chic accessory for the sunny days. This hat is so lightweight and breezy for when the sun is beaming down on you. You can style it with your favorite swimsuit and sandals, or accessorize with a pretty sundress.

The Sunny Days Hat is simply chic and ready for anything. Take it for sunbathing at the beach or for drinks in the evening. It works up fast and is very beginner friendly. All you have to know is how to work in rounds and single crochet.

I used Hobbii Summer Merino, which is a perfect blend between merino and cotton. It's perfect for a summer hat and it's all natural fibers. I used almost 2 skeins in color Curry (05) and just a bit of silver to make a brim. You can choose to make the hat in one single color or many colors.

Final measurements:

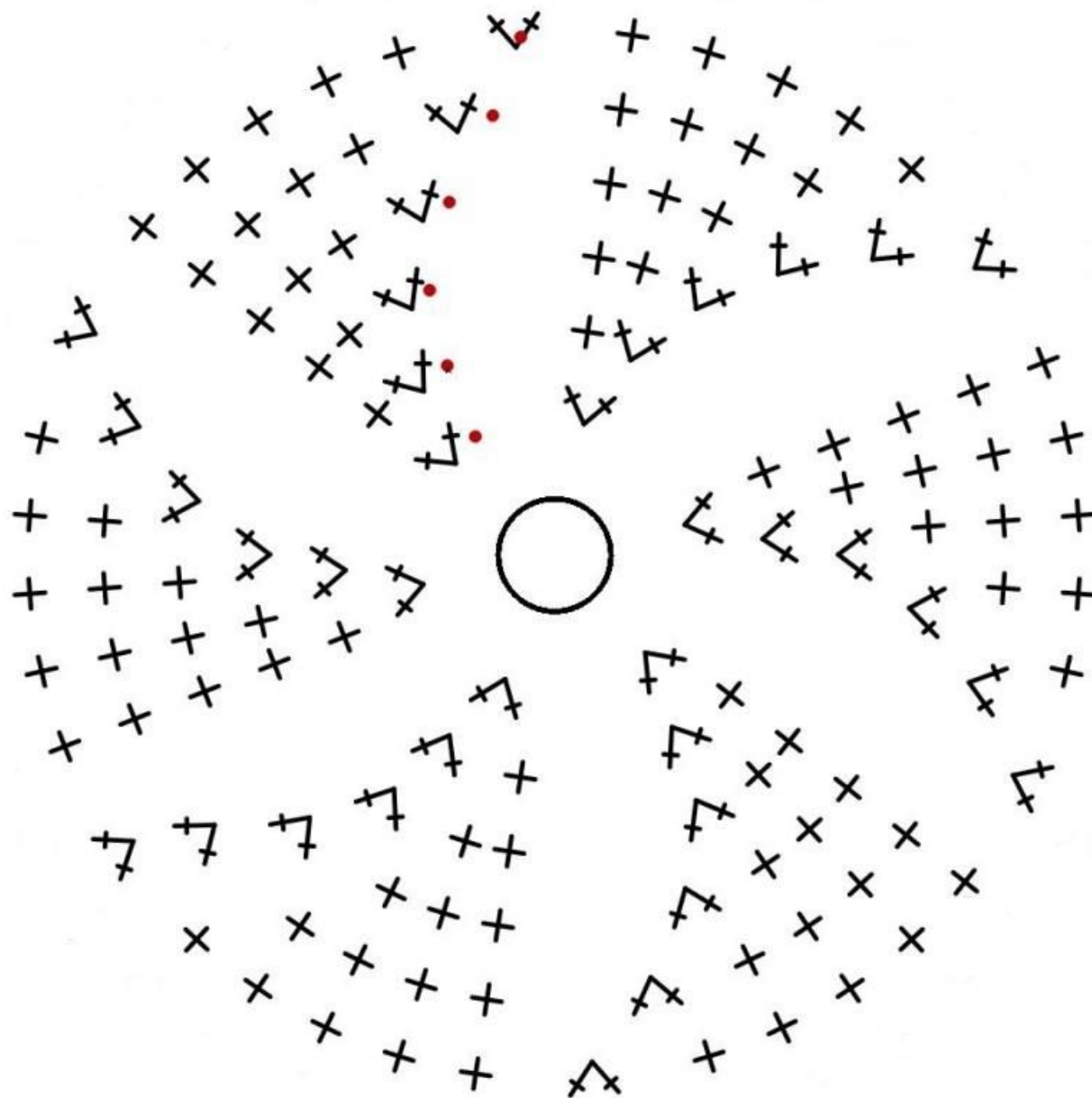
The Sunny Days Hat is one size, but it's very easy to adjust the final measurements by adding more rounds for the dome. If you need a wider outer rim you can work more rounds here as well. The pattern is written in US terms.

Diameter of dome = 17 cm

Diameter of outer rim = 37 cm

About the stitches

For this pattern we are using only single crochet. We will work the entire project in rounds, making some increasing to give it a hat shape. Below you will find a stitch chart with the first rounds of the dome.



Now that we have all the details in place, we can get started!



Pattern notes

We are working in rounds, joining with a sl st at the end of each round. Every round starts with ch 1. If you want you can work in continuous rounds as well, without making the sl st at the end of the round and the ch 1 at the beginning. In this case you will have to use a st. marker to mark the first st.

Round 1: Make a magic circle, ch 1 and 6 sc inside the ring. Pull the yarn to close the circle and join with sl st with first sc.

Round 2: Ch1, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in each st arounds (12 sc).

Round 3: *1 inc, 1 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (18)

Round 4: *1 inc, 2 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (24)

Round 5: *1 inc, 3 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (30)

Round 6: *1 inc, 4 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (36)

Round 7: *1 inc, 5 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (42)

Round 8: *1 inc, 6 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (48)

Round 9: *1 inc, 7 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (54)

Round 10: *1 inc, 8 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (60)

Round 11: *1 inc, 9 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (66)

Round 12: *1 inc, 10 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (72)

Round 13: *1 inc, 11 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (78)

Round 14: *1 inc, 12 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (84)

Round 15: *1 inc, 13 sc* repeat to the end of the round - 6 times in total (90)

After these 15 rounds the dome is done and we will continue working on the hat without increasing. If you need a wider dome you can continue working a few more rounds, just adding 1 sc between 2 increases with each round



Round 16: 1 sc in each st around

Rounds 17 – 24: repeat round 16

Rounds 25 – 28: change the color, in my case to silver and repeat round 16



Round 29: Change to the main color again and make *1 inc, 7sc* to the end of the round

Round 30: *1 inc, 8 sc* to the end of the round

Round 31: *1 inc, 9 sc* to the end of the round

Round 32: *1 inc, 10 sc* to the end of the round

Round 33: *1 inc, 11 sc* to the end of the round

Round 34: *1 inc, 12 sc* to the end of the round

Round 35: *1 inc, 13 sc* to the end of the round

You can notice that we started increasing again, working the outer rim.



Round 36: 1 sc in each st

Round 37: *1 inc, 14 sc* to the end of the round

Round 38: *1 inc, 15 sc* to the end of the round

Round 39: 1 sc in each st

Round 40: *1 inc, 16 sc* to the end of the round

Round 41: *1 inc, 17 sc* to the end of the round

Round 42: 1 sc in each st

Round 43: *1 inc, 18 sc* to the end of the round

Round 44: *1 inc, 19 sc* to the end of the round.

And the outer rim is done. If you want it to be wider, repeat a few more times 1 round in single crochet and 2 rounds increasing, adding 1 sc between increases with each round.
