



Fly Headband

No. 2003-192-8659

Materials

1 skein of 1.8 oz. (50 g) of Highland Wool col. 14

Circular needle: 31.5 inches (80 cm), US size 4 (3,5 mm)

Sizes

One size

Measurements

Width approx. 2.8 inches (7 cm) Length after knot approx. 19.7 inches (50 cm) Length before knot approx. 27.6 inches (70 cm) The yarn usage of the knot is approx. 7.9 inches (20 cm).

Pattern information

The headband is knitted back and forth in rib segments.

Edge stitch is abbreviated ES

Headband

Cast on 20 stitches.

The first stitch is an edge stitch. All edge stitches are slipped.

- 1. row: ES, *k1, p1* repeat until the end of the row.
- 2. row: ES, *p1, k1* repeat until the end of the row.
- 3. row: ES, k1, $p1^*$ repeat until the end of the row.
- = 1. segment
 - 4. row: ES, *k1, p1* repeat until the end of the row.
 - 5. row: ES, *p1, k1* repeat until the end of the row. .
 - 6. row: ES, *k1, p1* repeat until the end of the row.
- = 2. segment

Repeat these 6 rows until your work measures approx. 27.6 inches (70 cm)

Tie a knot in the middle of the headband and measure the length of the headband around your head to see if it fits.

Weave in the ends / attach the knot so the headband does not expand too much over time.

Bind off loosely and sew the ends together.
