



Angela Blouse

Materials

1 (1) 1 skein of 8.8 oz. (250 g) of Twister col. 21

2 (2) 2 skeins of 3.5 oz. (100 g) of Twister Solid col. 110

Circular needle US size 4 (3,5 mm) on 31.5 inches (80 cm)

Knitting gauge

25 stitches on 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch, 37 rounds on 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch

Sizes S (M) L

Measurements

Width: 43 (46) 49 cm Length, in the middle of the back: 48 (50) 50 cm

Pattern information

The blouse is knitted top-down with increases in stockinette stitch on the yoke.

Bind off for sleeves, and knit straight down in stockinette stitch.



Pattern

Using Twister Solid

Cast on 120 (132) 144 stitches and knit in the round using the circular needle, start from the inside of the skein.

Work 1 rnd of knit stitches, 1 rnd of purl and 1 rnd of knit.

Place a maker after every 10th, (11th) 12th stitch = 12 markers.

Yoke

The yoke is knitted in the round with increases in stockinette stitch.

Start the increases

- 1. rnd: knit *10 (11) 12 stitches, yarn over*, repeat from * to * around = 12 increases.
- 2. rnd: work all stitches knitwise and work the yarn over through the back loop.
- 3. rnd: work all stitches knitwise.
- 4. rnd: work all stitches knitwise.
- 5. rnd: knit *10 (11) 12 stitches, yarn over, knit 1*, repeat from * to * around = 12 increases.
- 6. rnd: work all stitches knitwise and work all yarn overs through the back loops.
- 7. rnd: work all stitches knitwise.
- 8. rnd: work all stitches knitwise.

Repeat 5. to 8. rnd, with 1 more stitch after the yarn over = increase every 4th rnd = 12 increases per rnd of increase.

Increase until you have 28 (30) 32 knit stitches between the increases = 336 (360) 384 stitches.

Put 66 (71) 76 stitches on hold for one sleeve, work the front piece, put 66 (71) 76 stitches on hold for the other sleeve, knit the back piece.

Body

Change thread to Twister. Start with the end of the cake that is the same color as your Twister Solid.

Cast on 5 (5) 6 stitches under each sleeve = 214 (228) 244 stitches.

Knit straight down in stockinette stitch until the work measures approx. 11.8 (12.6) 12.6 inches 30 (32) 32 cm) from the arm hole or until the desired length.

Knit 3 (knit) ridges.

Bind off.



Sleeves

Using Twister Solid

Place the sleeve stitches back on the needle. Knit up 5 (5) 6 stitches in the newly cast on stitches from the body = 71 (76) 82 sleeve stitches.

Place a marker mid under the sleeve:

Size S (M): place the marker around the 3rd stitch under the sleeve.

Size L: place the marker after the 3rd stitch.

Decrease by knitting until 3 (3) 2 stitches before the marker.

Size S (M): work 2 stitches together through the back loops, knit 1, work 2 stitches together knitwise

Size L: work 2 stitches together through the back loops, work 2 stitches together knitwise.

Knit in the round in stockinette stitch. Decrease approx. every 30th round, a total of 5 times = 61 (66) 72 stitches on the needle, knit until the sleeve measures 16.5 (16.9) 17.3 inches (42 (43) 44 cm).

Knit 3 (knit) ridges.

Bind off.
