



Beate Beret

Materials

1 (1) 1 skein of 8.8 oz. (250 g) Ribbon co. 02

Double Pointed needles (dpns) sz. 10 (6 mm) Circular needle 24" (60 cm) sz. 10 (6 mm) Stitch marker

Size

S (M) L

Measurements

Circumference, hem: 19.3" (20.9") 22.4" / 49 (53) 57 cm, stretches in width Diameter, beret: 11" (11.8") 12.6" / 28 (30) 32 cm

Gauge

14 sts on 4" (10 cm)

Abbreviation

1 st inc: pick up st between sts and knit (kw). A little hole is created.

Pattern information

The beret is knitted from the center top and with increases. After this, knit approx. 1.2" (3 cm) straight up before decreasing for hem.



Pattern

Cast on 8 sts on dpns and distribute the sts in order to knit in the round. **1st round:** knit. **2nd round:** *k1, 1 st inc*, repeat from * to * around = 16 sts. **3rd and all uneven rounds:** knit. **4th round:** *k2, 1 st inc*, repeat from * to * around = 24 sts. **6th round:** *k3, 1 st inc*, repeat from * to * around = 32 sts. **8th round:** *k4, 1 st inc*, repeat from * to * around = 40 sts. Continue like this with 1 more st between the increases until you have 112 (120) 128 sts all in all.

Note Switch to circular needles once you've got enough sts. Opt. knit using magic loop. Knit 5 rnds of stockinette.

Decreases:

1st round: *k 12 (13) 14, k2tog*, repeat from * to * around = 104 (112) 120 sts. **2nd and all even rounds:** knit. **3rd round:** *k 11 (12) 13, k2tog*, repeat from * to * around = 96 (104) 112 sts. **5th round:** *k 10 (11) 12, k2tog*, repeat from * to * around = 88 (96) 104 sts. **7th round:** *k 9 (10) 11, k2tog*, repeat from * to * around = 80 (88) 96 sts. **9th round:** *k 8 (9) 10, k2tog*, repeat from * to * around = 72 (80) 88 sts. **11th round:** *k 7 (8) 9, k2tog*, repeat from * to * around = 64 (72) 80 sts.

Hem

Knit 8 rounds of stockinette. Cast off knitwise.
