





Dolly Skirt

Skill level: Beginner

Sizes: S, M, L.

Crochet hook: 4 mm (US size G) **Materials:** Sewing needle, scissors

Yarn:

Pull Skein Cotton in color White (01) Cotton 8/4 Soft Print in color China Blue (206)

How much yarn do you need?

I used Hobbii Cotton Soft print in color China Blue as the main color. Each Skein has 50 grams and 170 m. For the stripes I used Hobbi Pull Skein in color White. One skein has 100 grams and 340 m.

- **S** = 200 grams / 680 m (3 skeins of china blue, 1 skein of white)
- **M** = 230 grams / 780 m (4 skeins of china blue, 1 skein of white)
- L = 260 grams/ 884 m (4 skeins of china blue, 1 skeins of white)

Abbreviations used in this pattern:

- Ch = chain
- **sc** = single crochet
- **Dc** = double crochet
- **St(s)** = stitch (es)

Gauge:

- **16 sc =** 10 cm
- **18 dc =** 10 cm
- 9 rows dc = 10 cm

Pattern Notes:

• Ch 1 and ch 2 at the beginning of each row/round doesn't count as the first sc/dc.

This Dolly Skirt is so cute! You can wear it with a t-shirt and a pair of sneakers for a more sporty look or match it with the **Kisa Tee** for a complete set.



About the design

The Design of this Dolly Skirt is super easy and any beginner will be able to make it. We will start with the waistband and then we will increase to create the shape. After we will join and start working in circular rounds, but we will keep working on the wrong and right side. In the length you can work as many rounds as you want.

About the yarn


For this pattern I used Hobbii Cotton 8/4 soft print and Hobbii cotton pull skein which are 100% cotton, but is so soft with a nice drape, perfect for this kind of project. It's a Fingering, 4 ply, Super Fine yarn.

About the stitch Pattern

We will use single crochet for the waistband and double crochet for the rest of the skirt.

Final Measurements

This pattern is available in 3 sizes from Small to Large and is written in US terms. The length of the skirt is the same for all sizes but you can easily make the dolly skirt longer just by adding more rounds. Below you will find the diagrams with the final measurements:







Now that we have all the details in place, let's start making this beautiful Dolly Skirt:

First the foundation chain:

- **S** = 122 sts
- **M** = 134 sts
- L = 150 sts



Row 1: Ch 1, starting with 2nd st, 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Ch 1 and turn

Row 2: 1 sc in each st across. Ch 1 and turn

Rows 3 – 4: Repeat row 2

Row 5: 1 sc in first 4 sts, ch 2, skip 2 (button hole) 1 sc in each st across. Ch 1 and turn

Rows 6 – 8: 1 sc in each stitch across. Ch 2 an turn

Row 9: 2 dc in each st across. Ch 2 and turn

Row 10: 1 dc in each st.



At round 11 we will join the ends and start working in circular rounds. This joining line will be on the side of the skirt.



Round 11

The 2 ends of the circle will overlap with 6 sts.

SI st 3 sts, ch 2, skip 3 sts from the other side and work the next 3 sts through both sides sts to make the join.

Continue with 1 dc in each sts. You have to work the last 3 dc through both sides. Join with a sl st with 1^{st} dc.





Round 12: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same st, 1 dc in each st around. SI st with 1st dc.

Rounds 13 – 23: Repeat round 12.

Rounds 24 – 28: Change to white and repeat round 12.



Rounds 29 – 32: Change again to China Blue and repeat round 12

Rounds 33 – 36: Change to white and repeat round 12.

Round 37: Change to China Blue and repeat round 12.

After completing 37 rounds the Dolly Skirt measures 34 cm. If you want a longer skirt you can add a few more rounds.

To finish the skirt, add a button and wave in all ends.
