Decorative Pumpkins Oblong

MATERIALS

1 skein of Friends Wool color 29 Buckthorn 1 skein of Friends Wool color 113 Misty Green

1 skein of Friends Wool color 114 Sage

Crochet hook 3 mm (US C/2) Markers

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii 100% wool, non superwash 50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (174 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

SI st - slip stitch

St(s) - stitch (es)

Hdc - Half double crochet

Blo - Back loop only

Mr - Magic ring

SIZE

Small (Large)

MEASUREMENTS

Small: 4 inches (10 cm) Large: 5.9 inches (15 cm)

ABOUT THE PATTERN

Autumn invites you to stay cozy at home, so why not crochet your own decorative pumpkins?

Create an authentic fall feeling with these crocheted ornaments. Use them as decoration in a dish, bowl or as a table decoration.

The pattern is made in this elongated model as well as the traditional round model. Both models are available in 2 sizes. Mix them in different colors.

INFO AND TIPS

When crocheting a striped pumpkin, change color after each row in the turning stitch. If you carry the yarn along within the stitches, you avoid having to weave in a lot of ends

NOTE: Turn by chaining 1 – It does not replace a stitch. From the 2nd row and onwards, crochet in the back loop only. The last stitch is worked through both loops of the stitch.

PATTERN - Instructions are available at the end of the pattern

Small:

1. Ch 26. Turn your foundation ch. Work 1 sc in the 2nd ch s from the crochet hook. Work 1 sc in the next 11 ch sts. Work 1 hdc in the next 11 ch sts. Work 1 sc in the last 2 ch sts.

From now on, work ONLY in the back loop (blo).

- 2. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1sc in the first 2 sts. Work 1 hdc in the next 11 sts. Work 1 sc in the last 12 sts.
- 3. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1sc in the first 12 sts. Work 1 hdc in the next 11 sts. Work 1 sc in the last 2 sts.

Repeat alternating between row 2 and 3 until you have 18 rows. **Assembly** – Please view the visual how-to-guide at the end of the pattern.

Stem:

- 1. Work a mr and work 6 sc into the ring. (6)
- 2. 5.Work sc around. (6)
- 6. Work 2 sc in each s around. Finish with 1 ss.(12)

Leave a long yarn tail for assembly. Sew the stem onto the top of the pumpkin. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



Large:

1. Ch 36. Turn your foundation ch. Work 1 sc in the 2. ch from the hook. Work 1 sc in the next 16 ch sts. Work 1 hdc in the next 15 ch sts. Work 1 sc in the last 3 ch sts.

From now on, work ONLY in the back loop (blo).

- 2. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts. Work 1 hdc in the next 15 sts. Work 1 sc in the last 17 sts.
- 3. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 sc in the first 17 sts. Work 1 hdc in the next 15 sts. Work 1 sc in the last 3 sts.

Repeat alternating between row 2 and 3 until you have 24 rows in total. **Assembly** – Please view the visual how-to-guide at the end of the pattern.

Stem:

- 1. Work a mr and work 8 sc into the ring. (8)
- 2.-6. Work sc around. (8)
- 7. Work 2 sc in each s around. Finish with 1 ss. (16) Leave a long tail for assembly. Sew the stem onto the top of the pumpkin. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

INSTRUCTIONS

Row 1



1. Ch 26 (36).



2. Turn your foundation ch and work in the vertical loops.





3. In the 2. ch stitch from the crochet hook, work 1 sc.



4. Like this.



5. Work 1 sc in the next 11 (16) ch sts.



6. Work1 hdc in the next 11 (15) ch sts.



7. Work 1 sc in the last 2 (3) ch sts.



Row 2



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. From now on, work ONLY in the back loops (blo).



3. Work 1 sc in the first 2 (3) sts.



4. Work 1 hdc in the next 11 (15) sts.



5. Work 1 sc in the last 12 (17) sts.



Row 3



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 sc in the first 12 (17) sts.



3. Work 1 hdc in the next 11 (15) sts.



4. Work 1 sc in the last 2 (3) sts.



5. Like this.



Row 4 and onwards.



1. Repeat alternating between row 2 and 3 until you have a total of 18 (24) rows.

ASSEMBLY

Now, crochet the sides together.

This is done by crocheting through both loops on the front piece and through the back loop on the back piece. Work ss around.

Now, you are going to sew the top of the pumpkin shut. Tack around the edge and pull the sts together, so the hole is completely shut.

Weave in the end. Turn the inside out of the pumpkin back inside.

Stuff it and shape it. Tack around the edge of the bottom of the pumpkin and pull the sts together so the hole is shut.



1. Now, the sides are crocheted together.



2. This is done by crocheting through both loops on the front piece and through the back loop on the back piece. Work ss around.





3. Like this.



4. Now, you are going to sew the top shut. Tack around the edge.



5. Pull the sts together so the hole is completely shut.



6. Weave in the end. Turn the inside out of the pumpkin back inside.



7. Stuff the pumpkin and shape it.



8. Tack around the edge of the bottom of the pumpkin and pull the sts together so the hole is shut.







9. Like this.

10. Weave in the end.



11. Sew the stem onto the top of the pumpkin. Weave in the ends.
