



Grit Baby Mittens

No. 2004-194-8667

Materials

1 (1, 1, 2) balls of 50 g Baby Merino XL col. 16

Single pointed needle size 3,5 mm (US4)
Crochet hook size 3 mm (US C/2) for the ties.

Yarn

Baby Merino XL, Hobbii,
100% merino wool/ 50 g = 105 m

Gauge

25 stitches x 34 rows in pattern = 10 cm

Size

0 (6, 12, 18) months

Measurements

Circumference: 13 (14, 15, 16) cm

Length: 11 (12, 13, 14) cm

Pattern Information

The mittens are worked bottom up in pattern. The top is worked in rib and stockinette st with decreases. Crochet a tie, which hereafter is sewn on to the mitten and tied with a bow in the front.

NB It isn't a "Knit 2, Purl 2 rib", but a shifted rib, due to the odd number of stitches.

Pattern

CO 33 (37, 41, 45) stitches and work back and forth in pattern:

Row 1, wrong side: *knit 2, purl 2*, repeat from * to * until you have 1 stitch left, knit 1.
Repeat this row until piece measures 9 (10, 11, 12) cm. Finish with a wrong side row.

Begin decreasing

Row 1, right side: *knit 2 together, purl 2 together*, repeat from * to * until you have 1 stitch left, knit 1 = 17 (19, 21, 23) stitches.

Row 2, wrong side: knit all knit stitches, purl all purl stitches.

Row 3, right side: knit 1, *knit 2 together*, repeat from * to * on entire row = 9 (10, 11, 12) stitches.

Row 4, wrong side: knit all knit stitches, purl all purl stitches.

Break off yarn, pull yarn through remaining stitches and fasten off.

Finish

Sew the seam of the mitten together.

Ties

Crochet 1 sc and ch 2.

*Work 1 sc in first ch and turn *, repeat from * to* until tie measures approx. 50 cm.

Fasten off all ends.

Sew the middle of the tie on to the seam approx. halfway on the mitten.

Work one more mitten with tie in the same way.
