



Mulle Children's Sweater

No. 2004-194-3557



Materials

1 skein of 7.1 oz. (200 g) Winter Glow color 09 **A**, dark and 1 skein of 7.1 oz. (200 g) Winter Glow color 01 **B**, bright

Yarn usage by size in stripes

approx. 2½ (2.7, 3, 3.3, 3½) oz. or 70 (77, 85, 92, 100) grams of resp. color **A** and color **B**

Yarn usage by size, solid color

Approx. 5 (5½, 6, 6½, 7) oz. or 140 (155, 170, 185, 200) grams

Yarn quality

Winter Glow, Hobbii

51% Wool, 49% Acrylic/ 7.1 oz. (200 g) = 766 yds (700 m)

Double pointed needles size 7 (4.5 mm) Circular needles 24" (60 cm) and 32" (80 cm), size 7 (4.5 mm)

Gauge

21 sts and 30 rnds on 4" (10 cm)

Sizes

4 (6, 8, 10 12) years

Measurements

Width: 13" (13.8", 14.6", 15.4", 16.1") or 33

(35, 37, 39, 41) cm

Length: 16½" (17.3", 18.1", 18.9", 19.7") or

42 (44, 46, 48, 50) cm

Pattern information

The sweater is knitted from the bottom and

Stripes are made by knitting 2 rounds of alternately dark and bright color.

The sleeves are knitted first so the body and the yoke have the same colorway.

Abbreviation

1 st inc: Pick up the stitch between the stitches and knit through back loop only.

Stripe pattern

Knit 2 rounds of color **A** and 2 rounds of color **B** all through the work. Wind the yarns around each other when you change the color.

Pattern

1st sleeve

Rib

Cast on 40 (42, 44, 46, 48) sts with color **A** on double pointed needles. Gather your work and knit in the round in a stripe pattern.

Knit 1.6" (4 cm) rib: k1, p1.

Place a marker at the beginning of the round.

Sleeve

Continue in stockinette st and stripe pattern. Knit 2 rounds.

Begin increases: Knit to 1 st before the marker, 1 st inc, k2, 1 st inc = 2 sts inc. Increase on every 10th (10th, 10th, 12th, 12th) round until you have 54 (56, 58, 60, 62) sts. Knit straight up until the work measures 11.8" (13", 14.2", 15", 15.7") or 30 (33, 36, 38, 40) cm.

Armhole

On the last round, cast off 4 sts like this:

Knit to 2 sts left on the round, cast off 4 sts.

Cut both yarns. Set the sts aside.

2nd sleeve

Knit another sleeve just the same.

Remember to finish on the same stripe before the armhole as on the first sleeve.

Body

Rib

Cast on 140 (148, 156, 164, 172) sts with color **A** on a 24" (60 cm) circular needle. Gather your work and knit in the round in a stripe pattern.

Knit 1.6" (4 cm) rib: k1, p1.

Place a marker at the beginning of the round and in the middle of the round = side seams = 70 (74, 78, 82, 86) sts on each part.

Continue in stockinette st and stripe pattern until the work measures 10" (10.6", 11", 11.8", 12.2") or 25 (27, 28, 30, 31) cm.

Remember to finish on the same stripe before the armhole as on the sleeves.



Armhole

On the last round, cast off 2x4 sts like this:

Knit to 2 sts before the side seam, cast off 4 sts, knit to 2 sts before the other side seam, cast off 4 sts.

Don't cut the yarn.

Now the sleeves are joined with the body and decreases for raglan is made.

Opt. switch to a 32" (80 cm) circular needle.

Knit the back, knit a sleeve, knit the front, knit a sleeve = 232 (244, 256, 268, 280) sts.

Note Place a marker in each joint.

It is on each side of these markers, you decrease for raglan, like this:

1st round: k1, k2tog tbl, *knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k2, k2tog tbl*, repeat from * to * 2 more times, knit to 3 sts before the marker, k2tog, k1 = 8 sts dec.

2nd round: Knit.

Repeat these 2 rounds until you have 88 (92, 96, 100, 104) sts.

Neckband

Knit 0.8" (2 cm) rib: k1, p1.

Cast off in rib using a stretchy bind off.

Finish

Sew together under the arms.
