Snowman Doll

No. 1011-194-7606

Skill level: Intermediate

Crochet hook: US size B/C-1/2 (2.5 mm)

Size: approx. 6" x 2½" (15 x 6 cm)

Materials: Pins, fiber filling, black embroidery yarn, safety eyes

(6mm).

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4:

Black (09)

Light purple (40)

Pastel mint (25)

Nude (03)

White (01)

Pink (44)

Brown (007)

How much yarn do you need?

You will need 1 skein of each color.



Abbreviations:

st = stitch

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

1 inc = increase, 2 sc in one st

1 dec = decrease, 2 sc worked together

sl st = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

Use a stitch marker or a safety pin to keep track of the beginning of the round.





Head

In nude

Start with a magic ring

R 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

R 2: [1 inc x6 (12)

R 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

R 4: 1 sc, 1 inc [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

R 5: [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

R 6: 2 sc, 1 inc [4 sc, 1 inc] x5, 2 sc (36)

R 7: [5 sc, 1 inc] x6 (42)

R 8-13: 42 sc (6 rounds, 42)

R 14: [5 sc, 1 dec] x6 (36)

Attach safety eyes between rounds 10-11 with 6 sts between the eyes.

R 15: 2 sc, 1 dec [4 sc, 1 dec] x5, 2 sc (30)

R16: [3 sc, 1 dec] x6 (24)

Put fiber filling in the head while you work your way up.

R 17: 1 sc, 1 dec [2 sc, 1 dec] x5, 1 sc (18)

R 18: [1 sc, 1 dec] x6 (12)

R 19: [1 dec] x6 (6)

Sew the hole. Embroider a black mouth. Embroider hair in brown or yellow yarn.

Cheeks (Make 2)

In pink

Start with a magic ring

R 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Finish with 1 sl st in the first sc. Weave in and leave a long tail, approx. 4" (10 cm) for sewing on the cheeks. Attach the cheeks.

Hood

In white

Start with a magic ring

R 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

R 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

R 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

R 4: 1 sc, 1 inc [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

R 5: [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

R 6: 2 sc, 1 inc [4 sc, 1 inc] x5, 2 sc (36)

R 7: [5 sc, 1 inc] x6 (42)

R 8-18: 42 sc (11 rounds, 42)

Weave in and leave a long tail for sewing. Place the hood on the head. Attach it to the head with small stitches.



Legs (Make 2)

Start in the color you want for the foot

R 1: Cast on 5 ch

R 2: Start in 2nd ch from the hook, 3 sc, 3 sc in the same st, turn without turning the work, 2 sc, 2 sc in the same st.

R 3: 2 sc in the same st, 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc.

R 4: Through back loop, 5 sc, 3 hdc, 6 sc

R 5: 4 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 st dec, 4 sc. Put fiber filling in the foot.

R 6: [1 dec] x6 (6)

R 7: Switch to pink, 6 sc (6)

R 8: Switch to white, 6 sc (6)

R 9: Switch to pink, 6 sc (6)

R 10: Switch to white, 6 sc (6)

R 11: Switch to pink, 6 sc (6)

R 12: *Switch to white,* 6 sc (6)

R 13: Switch to pink, 6 sc (6)

R 14: *Switch to white,* 6 sc (6)

R 15: *Switch to pink,* 6 sc (6)

Weave and leave a long tail for attaching the legs later on.

Body

In white

Start with a magic ring.

R 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

R 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

R 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

R 4: 1 sc, 1 inc [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

R 5: [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

R 6: 2 sc, 1 inc [4 sc, 1 inc] x5, 2 sc (36)

R 7: [5 sc, 1 inc] x6 (42)

R 8: 3 sc, 1 inc [6 sc, 1 inc] x5, 3 sc (48)

R 9: 48 sc (48)

R 10: [7 sc, 1 inc] x6 (54)

R 11-19: 54 sc (9 rounds, 54)

R 20: [7 sc, 1 dec] x6 (48)

R 21: 48 sc (48)

R 22: 3 sc, 1 dec [6 sc, 1 dec] x5, 3 sc (42)

R 23: [5 sc, 1 dec] x6 (36)

R 24: 2 sc, 1 dec [4 sc, 1 dec] x5 (30)

R 25: [3 sc, 1 dec] x6 (24)

Put fiber filling in the body and while you work on.

R 26: 1 sc, 1 dec [2 sc, 1 dec] x5 (18)

R27: [1 sc, 1 dec] x6 (12)



R 28: [1 dec] x6 (6)

Sew the hole and leave a long tail, approx. 12" (30 cm).

Use a long needle and pull the needle with the thread of yarn through the top of the body to the bottom, make a seam and then pull the needle from the bottom and back to the top. Tighten the thread a little.

Arms (Make 2)

In nude

Start with a magic ring.

R 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

R 2-3: 6 sc (2 rounds, 6)

R 4: *Switch to pink,* 6 sc (6)

R 5: *Switch to white,* 6 sc (6)

R 6: *Switch to pink,* 6 sc (6)

R 7: Switch to white, 6 sc (6)

R 8: Switch to pink, 6 sc (6)

R 9: Switch to white, 6 sc (6)

R 10: Switch to pink, 6 sc (6)

Weave in and leave a long tail for sewing the arms to the body.

Scarf

In mint

Make 49 chains

R 1: Start in 2nd ch from the hook, 48 sc, make 1 ch and turn

R 2: 48 sc, make 1 ch and turn

R 3: 48 sc.

Weave in ends.

Hat

In black

Start with a magic ring

R 1: 6 sc in the magic ring

R 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

R 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

R 4: [2 sc, 1 inc] x6 (24)

R 5: Through back loop only, 24 sc (1 round, 24)

R 6-7: 24 sc (2 rounds, 24)

R 8: Switch to mint, 24 sc (24)

R 9: Switch to black, 24 sc (24)

R 10: [1 sc, 1 inc] repeat across (36)

R 11-12: 36 sc (2 rounds, 36)

Finish with 1 sl st. Weave in ends.



Buttons (Make 2)

In black

Start with a magic ring

R 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

Finich with 1 sl st in the first st. Weave in ends and leave a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

Place the head with the hood on top of the body using pins and sew on.

Place the legs with the pins and sew them on one at the time. Do the same with the arms.

Make the scarf and sew it on the snowman with small stitches.

Place the buttons with the pins and attach them. Do the same with the hat.

The snowman is ready!
