## Baby

Model: Go handmades  
Cardigan Moss Stitch



*Knitted in Go handmades' Tencel Bamboo "double"  
- deliciously soft with a wonderful silky sheen and  
great strength. 40% Tencel/60% Bamboo, 50 g/130 m.*



### YARN USAGE

Pattern: 3 mths. 6 mths.  
Tencel Bamboo (Double): 150 g 200 g

Buttons

Needles: 3.0 and 3.5 mm

Double-pointed needles for sleeves: 3.5 mm

Gauge: 3.5 mm/28 sts Stockinette stitch/10 cm

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## Tencel Bamboo "double"

- a sustainable yarn



Tencel is an organic sustainable natural material made from wood chips, primarily from beech trees and eucalyptus. The tree is FSC certified and comes from natural thinning of forests and residues from other tree productions.

**Uniqueness** - This yarn, made of silky soft and smooth Tencel and bamboo fibers, has a very delicate thread, indeed unique and fascinating to work with. The thread might be spun looser in some spots of the yarn, which is a natural part of its character. The result will be so gorgeous.

Children will love this yarn as it is incredibly gentle and soft against the skin.  
40% Tencel/60% Bamboo, 50 g/130 m.



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## YARN USAGE:

### Size 3 months:

150 g Tencel Bamboo (Double)

### Size 6 months:

200 g Tencel Bamboo (Double)

## MATERIAL:

Buttons

Needle 3,0 and 3,5 mm

Double pointed needles for sleeves 3,5 mm

Gauge with 3,5 mm needle:

28 sts stockinette stitch = 10 cm

*Specified yarn quantities are indicative.*

## ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
N	Needle(s)
r	Row
p	Purl
twk	Twisted knit
M	Marker
inc	Increase: pick up the loop between 2 sts and knit or purl as it fits with the pearl st
k2tog	Knit 2 sts together
p2tog	Purl 2 together
Moss stitch	1. r: {k1, p1} 2. r: {p1, k1} = k over p and p over k
Buttonhole	Bind off 2 sts, cast on 2 new sts above the bound off sts in the following r.
Cable	1. r: p1, k4, p1 2. r: k1, p4, k1 3. r: p1, put 2 sts on an aux N in front of the work, knit 2 sts from N, then the 2 sts from the aux N, finish with p1 4. r: k1, p4, k1 <i>See chart</i>
Raglan	Decrease on each side of the cable, yarn over, 1 twk (yarn over is worked in moss stitch)
(..)	Number of sts per row in both sizes. Size 6 months appears in brackets. Size: 3 months (6 months)

## CARDIGAN WITH MOSS STITCH 3 MONTHS (6 MONTHS)

*The cardigan is worked from top to bottom.*  
Cast on 72 (78) sts on 3,0 mm needles.  
Work 9 (11) r in moss stitch.

### SLEEVES, BACK AND FRONT

Change to N 3,5 mm and divide piece for sleeves, back and front parts - at the same time, make the first buttonhole within the first/last 8 (10) sts.  
*The buttonhole is repeated 4 (5) times with approx. 4 (5) cm in-between.*

Knit 12 (14) sts moss st, inc, p1, k4, p1 (*cable*), inc, 6 (6) sts moss st, inc, p1, k4, p1 (*cable*), inc, 12 (14) sts moss st, inc, p1, k4, p1 (*cable*), inc, 6 (6) sts moss st, inc, p1, k4, p1 (*cable*), inc, 12 (14) sts moss st. Decrease on each side of the cable every other row - 18 (20) times - total 216 (238) sts.

Knit until raglan measures 11 (12) cm.  
Slide the sleeve sts onto an aux N - total 42 (46) m - set aside.

### FRONT, BACK AND FRONT

*Continue with front, back and front as follows:*  
8 (10) sts moss st (button edge), 22 (25) sts stockinette st over the rest of the front piece, 6 (6) sts cable, cast on 10 (12) new sts under the sleeve (*knit them in moss st - beware that they fit with the button edges*), 6 (6) sts cable, knit back 48 (52) sts stockinette st, 6 (6) sts cable, cast on 10 (12) new sts under the sleeve (*knit in moss st - again, be careful that they fit with the button edge*), 6 (6) sts cable, 22 (25) sts stockinette st, 8 (10) sts moss st

(button edge).  
Knit until the work measures 22 (26) cm (or desired length).  
*Change to 3,0 mm N.*  
Knit 9 (11) r moss st.  
*Bind off.*

### SLEEVES

*Knit in the round with double pointed N in moss st.*  
Cast on 10 (12) new sts in the armhole - total 52 (58) sts - place M in the center of the sts .  
Decrease in the center of the sleeve every 8 r - 6 (8) times - total 40 (42) sts, as follows:  
k2tog or p2tog (*as it fits with the moss st*), knit until the last 2 sts and then again k2tog or p2tog (*as it fits with the moss st*).  
Knit the sleeve until it measures 13 (16) cm (or desired length).  
*Change to 3,0 mm N.*  
Knit 8 r moss st.  
*Bind off.*


### ASSEMBLY

*Sew together under the sleeves.*  
*Weave in the ends. Sew buttons.*

### FINAL DIMENSIONS OF THE CARDIGAN

Width	52 (54) cm.
Length	24 (28) cm.
Sleeve length	15 (18) cm.

## CHART



● = purl on the RS, knit on the WS

□ = knit on the RS, purl on the WS

↘ = cable: place the first 2 sts on an aux N in front of the work, knit the following 2 sts from the N, knit the 2 sts from the aux N.

## Good to know

### Needle Size + Tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us.

The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles.

Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.



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
