



Cora - Blouse

Materials

6 (7, 7, 8, 8) skeins of Diablo col. 11

Circular needle US size 7 (4.5 mm) and 10 (6 mm) / 31.5 inches (80 cm)

Stitch holders incl. a wire

Stitch markers

Yarn quality

Diablo, Hobbii

30% mohair, 30% nylon, 40% acrylic, 0.9 oz. (25 g) = 246 yards (225 meter)

Knitting gauge on knitting needle
US size 10 (6 mm)

15 stitches and 20 rounds on 4 inches (10 cm) with 2 threads in stockinette stitches.

Sizes

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

Measurements

Width (Measured flat): 18.9 (20.5, 22, 23.6, 25.2) inches (48 (52, 56, 60, 64) cm)

Length, mid front: 21.3 (22, 22, 22, 22) inches (54 (56, 56, 56, 56) cm)

Pattern information

The blouse is knitted in 2 threads, top-down. The yoke and the sleeves are knitted using the magic loop technique. The yoke is decorated with knitted cables, the body and sleeves are knitted in stockinette stitches.

The edges are also decorated with knitted cables.

Explanation of knitting terms:

Make 1 increase purlwise: pick up the loop between the stitches and purl the loop from the back.

cable: knit the 2nd stitch on the left needle **from the back** knitwise, let the stitch stay on the left needle, knit the 1st stitch **from the front** knitwise and slip both stitches onto the right needle.

Pattern

Neckband

Cast on 96 stitches on US needle 7 (4.5 mm) with 2 threads. Knit in the round on the circular needle.

Work 1 round knitwise.

Continue with cables like this:

1. round: *knit the 2nd stitch on the left needle **from the back** knitwise, let the stitch stay on the left needle, knit the 1st stitch **from the front** knitwise and slip both stitches onto the right needle*, repeat from * to * around = 48 cables.

2. round: knit each stitch knitwise.

Repeat these 2 rounds until the edge measures 1.6 inches (4 cm)

Yoke

Switch to circular needle US size 10 (6 mm).

Start increasing

All sizes

1. round with increases:

1. round: *knit 1 cable, purl 1 increase*, repeat from * to * around = 144 stitches.

2. round: *knit 2, purl 1*, repeat from * to* around.

3. round: *1 cable, purl 1*, repeat from * to* around.

4. round: *knit 2, purl 1*, repeat from * to* around.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

2. round with increases:

1. round: *1 cable, purl 1, purl 1 increase*, repeat from * to * around = 192 stitches.

2. round: *knit 2, purl 2*, repeat from * to * around.

3. round: *1 cable, purl 2*, repeat from * to * around.

4. round: *knit 2, purl 2*, repeat from * to* around.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

3. round with increases:

1. round: *1 cable, purl 1, purl 1 increase, purl 1*, repeat from * to * around = 240 stitches.

2. round: *knit 2, purl 3*, repeat from * to * around.

3. round: *1 cable, purl 3*, repeat from * to * around.

4. round: *knit 2, purl 3*, repeat from * to* around.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

Note: Size **S** does not have further increases.

Size M ONLY:**4. round with increases:**

1. round: *1 cable, purl 2, purl 1 increase, purl 1, 1 cable, purl 3,* , repeat from * to * around = 264 stitches.

2. round: Knit as the stitches show.

3. round: Knit as the stitches show, but twist the 2 knit stitches.

4. round: Knit as the stitches show.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

Note: Size **M** does not contain further increases.

Sizes L, XL, XXL:**4. Round with increases**

1. round: *1 cable, purl 2, purl 1 increase, purl 1* , repeat from * to * around = 288 stitches.

2. round: *knit 2, purl 4* , repeat from * to * around

3. round: *1 cable, purl 4 * , repeat from * to * around.

4. round: *knit 2, purl 4* , repeat from * to* around.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

Note: Size **L** does not contain further increases.

Size XL ONLY:**5. Round with increases**

1. round: *1 cable, purl 2, purl 1 increase, purl 2, 1 cable, purl 4* , repeat from * to * around = 312 stitches.

2. round: knit as the stitches show

3. round knit as the stitches show, but twist the 2 knit stitches.

4. round: knit as the stitches show.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

Note: Size **XL** does not contain further increases.

Size XXL ONLY:**5. Round with increases**

1. round: *1 cable, purl 2, purl 1 increase, purl 2* , repeat from * to * around = 336 stitches.

2. round: *knit 2, purl 5* , repeat from * to * around.

3. round: knit as the stitches show, but twist the 2 knit stitches.

4. round: *knit 2, purl 5* , repeat from * to* around.

Repeat the 3. and 4. round for a total of 6 times. 14 rounds are knit in total for this increase part.

Note: Size **XXL** does not contain further increases.

All sizes

Knit 2 rounds knitwise.

Divide for sleeves and body

Place 48 (54, 60, 66, 72) stitches on a stitch holder using the wire for the sleeve, knit over the following 72 (78, 84, 90, 96) stitches for the body, place 48 (54, 60, 66, 72) stitches on a stitch holder using the wire for the sleeve, knit over the following 72 (78, 84, 90, 96) stitches for the body.

Body

Knit in the round over the 144 (156, 168, 180, 192) stitches of the body.

Continue straight up in stockinette stitches until your work measures approx. 13 (11.8, 11.8, 10.6, 10.6) inches (33 (30, 30, 27, 27) cm) from the yoke.

On the next round decrease evenly with 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) stitches = 134 (144, 154, 164, 174) stitches.

Blouse-edge

Switch to US needle 7 (4.5 mm) and knit cables as you did with the neckband.

Knit until the edge measures 1.96 inches (5 cm).

Bind off very loosely or bind off using an elastic bind off technique.

Sleeves

Place the 48 (54, 60, 66, 72) stitches of the sleeve on needle size 10 (6 mm).

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of the round.

Knit in the round in stockinette stitches as you decrease with 1 stitch on each side of the marker: knit until 3 stitches before the marker, knit 2 stitches together through the back loops, knit 2, knit 2 together = 2 decreases.

Decrease for every 16th (12th, 10th, 8th, 6th) round = 4 (6, 8, 10, 12) times until you have 40 (42, 44, 46, 48) stitches.

Knit straight up until the sleeve measures approx. 15 inches (38 cm) or until the desired length. On the next round, decrease evenly so you have 28 (30, 32, 34, 36) stitches.

Cuff

Switch to US needle 7 (4.5 mm). Knit 1.96 inches (5 cm) of cables as you did with the neckband.

Bind off very loosely, or bind off using an elastic bind off technique.

Knit the other sleeve the same way.
