



Cleo - Tube Scarf

No. 1001-194-6619

Materials:

Alpaca Bris from Viking Yarn - col. 315
Crochet hook 7 mm

Measurements: Ca. 26 cm tall and ca. 152 cm in circumference

Tension: Ca. 12 st x 10 rows = 10 x 10 cm in pattern

Yarn needed: Ca. 200 g. (4 skeins)

Abbreviations:

ch: chain

st: stitch

sl st: slip stitch

sc: single crochet

dc: double crochet

BPdc: back post double crochet

FPdc: front post double crochet

The pattern is divisible by 8. If you want your scarf longer, just add more chains, but remember the number must be divisible by 8.

Pattern: A picture guide is found below the pattern.

1. Ch 184, and gather into a ring with 1 sl st.
2. Ch 3 (replaces the 1st dc). Crochet 1 dc in every ch of the round. Finish with 1 sl st. (184)
3. Ch 1. Crochet *1 FPdc around the next 4 st, 1 BPdc around the next 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round, and finish with 1 sl st.
4. Now repeat round 3. Ch 1. Crochet *1 FPdc around the next 4 st, 1 BPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round, and finish with 1 sl st.
5. The pattern will now be shifted. Ch 1. Crochet *1 BPdc around the next 4 st, 1 FPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round, and finish with 1 sl st.
6. Now repeat round 5. Ch 1. Crochet *1 BPdc around the next 4 st, 1 FPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round, and finish with 1 sl st.

Repeat rounds 3-6 6 times in total.

Ch 1, and now crochet 1 sc in every st until the end of the round and finish with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



Guide:

Round 1



1. Make a ch row, and gather into a ring with 1 sl st.

Round 2



1. Ch 3 (replaces the 1st dc)



2. Crochet 1 dc in all the ch until the end of the round and finish with 1 sl st.

Round 3



1. Ch 1. Crochet 1 FPdc. This is done around the dc in the row/round below. The needle in the picture marks where to crochet around the dc post from the front.



2. Like this. You have now crocheted 1 FPdc.



3. Crochet 1 FPdc around the next dc.



4. Like this. You have now crocheted 2 FPdc.



5. Crochet 1 FPdc around the next 2 dc.



6. Now crochet 1 BPdc around the dc in the row/round underneath. The needle in the picture marks where to crochet around the dc post from behind.



7. Like this. You now have crocheted 1 BPdc.



8. Crochet 1 BPdc around the next dc.



9. Like this. You have now crocheted 2 BPdc.



10. Crochet 1 BPdc around the next 2 dc.



11. Now repeat the pattern. Crochet *1 FPdc around the next 4 st, 1 BPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round.



12. Finish the round med 1 sl st.

Round 4



1. Now repeat round 3. Ch 1, and crochet 1 FPdc around the dc.



2. Repeat and crochet 1 FPdc around the next 3 dc.



3. Crochet 1 BPdc around the next dc.



4. Repeat and crochet 1 BPdc around the next 3 dc.



5. Repeat the pattern. Crochet *1 FPdc around the next 4 st, 1 BPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round. Finish with 1 sl st.

Round 5



1. The pattern will now be shifted. Ch 1. Crochet 1 BPdc around the first dc.



2. Repeat and crochet 1 BPdc around the next 3 dc.



3. Crochet FPdc around the next dc.



4. Repeat and crochet 1 FPdc around the next 3 dc.



7. Repeat the pattern. Crochet *1 BPdc around the next 4 st, 1 FPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round, and finish with 1 sl st.

Round 6



1. Repeat round 5. Ch 1. Crochet 1 BPdc around the first dc.



2. Repeat and crochet 1 BPdc around the next 3 dc.



3. Crochet 1 FPdc around the next dc.



4. Repeat and crochet 1 FPdc around the next 3 dc.



5. Repeat the pattern. Crochet *1 BPdc around the next 4 st, 1 FPdc around the following 4 st*. Repeat * to * until the end of the round, and finish with 1 sl st.

6. Now repeat rounds 3-6 as described in the pattern.
