# Pattern Rib Stitch Hat 

## YARN USAGE

H 24 cm x head circumference $56-60 \mathrm{~cm}$ Cosy: $100-150 \mathrm{~g}$

Crochet hook: 3,5-4,5 mm
Gauge: 20 htr/ 10 cm

Pompon
'Handmade' label


Crocheted in Go handmade's Cosy - a wonderfully soft and high quality cotton mix that keeps the shape. $60 \%$ Cotton $/ 40 \%$ Acrylic, $50 \mathrm{~g} / 100 \mathrm{~m}$



## YARN USAGE

H $24 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ Head circumference 56.60 cm
Cosy: 100-150 g
Crochet hook: 3,5-4,5 mm
Gauge: $20 \mathrm{htr} / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

## THE SIZE OF THE HAT

Find the heads circumference by measuring above the eyebrows and around the head.

## ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s) Stitch(es)
ch st Chain stitch
sl st Slip stitch
htr Half treble
t-ch Turn chain stitch, 1 ch st then turn the work
bl Back loop
(..) At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches

## Rib Stitch Hat - H 24 cm

For all head circumferences - i.e. $56 \mathrm{~cm},(58 \mathrm{~cm}), 60 \mathrm{~cm}$ Many adult sizes are between $56 \mathrm{~cm}-60 \mathrm{~cm}$.

## Important regarding the pattern:

The foundation chain equals THE HEIGHT of the hat.
The final length of the crochet rows shall fit the desired circumference.

## Pattern:

Crochet a foundation chain with 63 ch st.
Should you wish to have the hat longer - increase the number of ch st.
And equally - for a shorter hat - decrease the number of ch st.
The hat is crochet in rows, all rows start in the 2nd st from the hook and turn with 1 t-ch.
1.) $\quad 1 \mathrm{htr}$ in each st
2.) $\quad 14 \mathrm{htr}$ in the front 3rd loop, 48 htr in bl
3.) $\quad 48 \mathrm{htr}$ in the front 3 rd loop, 14 htr in bl

Repeat row 2 and 3 until you reach the desired circumference i.e. $56(58) 60 \mathrm{~cm}$.

## Tip:

Should you require a smaller or larger circumference on the hat, crochet more or fewer repeats of row 2 and 3.
We recommended measuring your work as you progress until you reach your desired circumference.


## 3RD LOOP

The 3rd loop can be seen as an almost horizontally placed loop (see picture A).


The front 3rd loop is located at the front of the work under the front loop. The back 3rd loop is located at the back of the work under the back loop.

## Assembly

Fold the hat and crochet the sides together with sl st on the wrong side (picture 1-2). Gather the top of the hat like a 'bouquet' and stitch together on the wrong side (picture 3). Turn the hat the right way.
The fastener for the pompon is sew at the top of the hat and the pompon attached. Turn up the hem and sew it to the hat (picture 4) - make sure not to sew it too tightly.


## Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size $2,0 \mathrm{~mm}$ and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size $4,0 \mathrm{~mm}$. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.


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
