



Purple Clouds Jacket

No. 1006-194-1073

Sizes: S, M, L, XL.

Skill Level: Beginner

Crochet Hook: 6 mm (US size J)

Materials: Stitch markers

Yarn: Summer Cloud - Blackcurrant (09)

How much yarn do you need?

S - 10 skeins

M - 12 skeins

L - 13 skeins

XL - 14 skeins

Abbreviations used in this pattern:

Ch - chain

Hdc - half double crochet

Dc - double crochet

Sc - single crochet

Sl st - slip stitch

St(s) - stitch (es)

Inc - increase (1 hdc, ch 2, 1 hdc)

Dec - decrease (sc2tog – 2 single crochet worked together)

Gauge: 11 hdc = 10 cm. 9 rows = 10 cm.

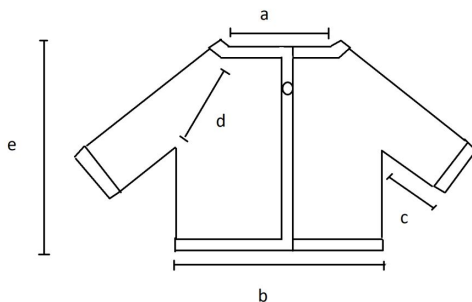
Pattern notes:

The Ch 2 at the beginning of each round counts as the first hdc.

Design

Being both versatile and easy to make, this jacket is a must have! The Purple Clouds Jacket is worked top-down and has an oversized fit with a positive ease of 9 cm around the bust circumference. The pattern is available in 5 sizes from Small to XL and is written in US terms.

First we will work the yoke and then divide it for sleeves and body. At the end we will add a border and attach the button. The final measurements of the jacket for each size are represented in the diagram below:



Neck Line a: 18 cm (22, 24, 25)

Bust Width b: 52 cm (57, 62, 67)

Underarm Length c: 26 cm (26, 26, 26)

Yoke Depth d: 22 cm (24, 26, 28)

Length e: 44 cm (45, 47, 48)

Yoke

*for the yoke the number of sts for sizes M, L and XL are written between brackets.

Foundation chain:

- S – 64 sts
- M – 72 sts
- L – 76 sts
- XL - 82 sts

Row 1

Ch 2, starting with 4th st 1 hdc in next 9 (11, 12, 13) sts, 1 inc in next st, 1 hdc in next 10 (10, 10, 11) sts, 1 inc in next, 1 hdc in next 20 (24, 26, 28) sts, 1 inc in next, 1 hdc in next 10 (10, 10, 11) sts, 1 inc in next, 1 hdc in last 10 (12, 13, 14) sts, Ch 2 and turn.

Row 2

Starting with 2nd st [1 hdc in each st until you get to the next corner (ch 2 space from the previous round), 1 inc in the ch 2 space]. Repeat to the end of the row. Last hdc will be made in the 2nd st of the turning ch. Ch 2 and turn.



Repeat round 2 until you have in total:

- **S** – 14 rounds
- **M** – 15 rounds
- **L** – 17 rounds
- **XL** – 18 rounds

After finishing the yoke, we will separate the body and the sleeves and start working the 3 parts individually.

Body

Row 1

Start the round as usual. 1 hdc in each st until you reach the first corner. In the first corner make 1 hdc, ch 7, skip the sts for the sleeve, 1 hdc in the 2nd corner, 1 hdc in each stitch until you reach the 3rd corner, 1 hdc in the corner, ch 7, skip the sts for the 2nd sleeve, 1 hdc in the 4th corner, 1 hdc in each st until you reach the end of the row. Ch 2 and turn. Work 1 hdc in each st around until you reach the desired length or until you have 23 rows in total.

Sleeves

Insert the yarn in the armpit. We will be working in rounds this time, working on the right and wrong side. So turn after each round.

Round 1

1 hdc in each st around.

Round 2

1 dec, 1 hdc in each st until you have 2 sts left, 1 dec. Join with a sl st in the first sc cluster.

Round 3 - 6

1 hdc in each st around.

Repeat rounds 2-6 until you have 23 rounds in total for the sleeve. If you want a longer sleeve after round 23 you can work a few more rounds without decreasing.



Next, we will work a border all around the jacket. I started in the middle bottom back. Insert the yarn, make 1 sc in each stitch around the jacket margins. When you get to the corners make 3 sc. We will work 4 rounds in total and on the 3rd round we will make a button hole on the left side, after 4 sts from the top. I made the button hole, by chaining 2 and skipping 2 sts.

After completing the 4 rows, the jacket is done and all you have to do is to weave in the ends, sew on a button and the Purple Clouds Jacket is ready to be worn!
