



Tip-To-Tip Shawl - Carnival

Materials:

- Carnival col. 01

- Crochet hook size 5.5 mm

Buy yarn and accessories here:

Usage approx.: 325g (4 balls)

Gauge: Approx. 15 st x 8 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$

Measurements: Ca. 210 x 57 cm

Abbreviations:

St: stitch(es)

Ch: chain stitch **Dc:** double crochet



Information:

All rows are turned with ch 3, which equals 1 dc. The last dc is worked in the third ch from previous row. Please note, that it tends to hide a little bit \mathfrak{S}



Pattern:

1. Ch 3 and work 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. (2)





2. Ch 3 to turn. Work 1 dc in first st and 1 dc in last st. (3)



1. Ch 3 to turn. (represents 1 dc)



2. Increase by working 1 dc in first st. Here the stitch is marked by the needle.



3. Like this. You now have 2 dc i first m, da de ch 3 represents 1 dc.



4. Work 1 dc in last st. You have now increased 1 st on this row.



3. Ch 3 to turn. Work 1 dc in first st and 1 dc each of the last 2 st. (4)



1. Ch 3 to turn.



2. Work 1 dc in first st. (The needle shows the first st).



3. Like this. You have now increased 1 st.



4. Work 1 dc in each of the last 2 st.

4. - **83.** Repeat the procedure: "Ch 3 to turn and work 1 dc in first st. Continue working 1 dc in each st on the rest of the row" until you have worked 83 rows. (84)

Now the shawl doesn't need to be any wider and you continue decreasing 1 st in every row. The decrease is worked as follows:

84.Ch 3 to turn. Work the first 2 dc together (dc2tog) and continue working 1 dc in each st on the rest of the row. (83)





1. Ch 3 to turn.



2. Now work the decrease. This is done by working the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} st together.



3. Like this.



4. Work 1 dc in each st on the rest of the row.



85. Ch 3 to turn. Dec2tog and work 1 dc in each st on the rest of the row. (82)



1. Ch 3 to turn.



2. Now work the decrease. This is done by working the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} st together.



3. Like this.



4. Work 1 dc in each st on the rest of the row.

86. - **165.** Repeat the procedure: "Ch 3 to turn. Dc2tog and work 1 dc in each st on the rest of the row" until you have worked a total of 165 rows. (2) Cut yarn and weave in ends.







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
