



# Juniper - Shawl

#### Materials

7 (7) skeins of Manarola col. 06 or Carnival col. 4

Circular needle 31.5 inches (80 cm), US size: 7 (4.5 mm)

# Yarn Quality

Manarola, World of Yarn

100% acrylic/ 3.53 oz. (100 g) = 262 yards (240 m)

or

Carnival, Hobbii

100% acrylic/ 3.53 oz. (100 g) = 262 yards (240 m)

## Knitting gauge

20 stitches on 4 inches (10 cm) in garter stitches

#### Sizes

Small (Large)

#### Measurements

Width: 66.9 (70.9) inches (170 (180) cm) Length: 33.5 (39.4) inches (85 (100) cm)

#### Pattern information

The shawl is knitted back and forth on a circular needle using the technique Entrelac / Neverkont.

You start with one row of half squares and then you continue working whole squares. For each row you knit, you will get one square less than you had on the previous row until you have only 1 square left. To get the prettiest result, you shouldn't change yarn skein in the middle of a square.

#### **Pattern**

Cast on 260 (300) stitches on a circular needle and knit 1 row knitwise.

#### **Neverkont / Entrelace**

Start pattern by knitting half squares:

#### First row

#### Half squares

\*1 row: knit 2 together, turn

2. row: knit 1

3. row: knit 2, turn

4. row: knit 2

5. row: knit 3, turn

6. row: knit 3

7. row: knit 4, turn

8. row: knit 4

Continue like this by knitting 1 stitch more from the needle until you have 19 stitches on the right needle. Put these stitches on hold on the needle\*.

**Note:** This is the first haæf square. Place a marker after these 19 stitches.

Repeat from \* to \* until you have 13 (15) half squares and all stitches on the cast on edge are knitted. The stitches of the last half square are bound off and the last stitch stays on the needle.

#### Second row

#### 1. whole squares

Knit up 18 stitches along the side of the half square = 19 stitches on the right needle, turn.

1. row: knit 19

2. row: knit 18, knit 2 together, turn

3. row: knit 19

4. row: knit 18, knit 2 together, turn

5. row: knit 19

Continue knitting 1 stitch more from the next half square until these stitches are knitted. Let these stitches stay on the needle.

#### 2. Whole squares

\*\*knit 19 stitches along the side of the half square, turn.

1. row: knit 19

2. row: knit 18, knit 2 together, turn

3. row: knit 19

4. row: knit 18, knit 2 together, turn

5. row: knit 19



Continue to knit 1 more stitch from the next half square until these stitches are knitted. Let these stitches stay on the needle \*\*.

Repeat from \*\* to \*\* until you have knitted in each half square = (12) 14 whole squares. The stitches on the last square are bound off and the last stitch stays on the needle.

### Third row

This row is knitted just like the 2nd row, but on the following rows between the whole squares = 11 (13) whole squares.

# Fourth to the 13th row (15th row):

Continue like this until you have 1 square left.

Fasten off and weave in the end.
