



# Snip Snip - Scarf

## Materials

3 skeins of Universe col. 10

Knitting needles US size 4 (3.5 mm)

Stitch markers

## Yarn quality

**Universe**, Hobbii

98% acrylic, 2% polyester/

3.53 oz. (100 g) = 505.2 yards (462 m)

## Knitting gauge

22 stitches and 50 rows = 10x10 cm in garter stitches

## Size

One size

## Measurements

Width, measured in the middle: 29.5 inches (75 cm)

Length: 74.8 inches (190 cm)

## Pattern information

The scarf is knitted in garter stitches. Increases are made at both sides to the middle, hereafter, decreases are made at both sides.

### **Pattern**

Cast on 3 stitches and knit garter stitches.  
Work 3 rows.

### **Start increasing**

Work 1 increase in each side like this:

Knit 1, knit up the loop and work it through the back loop knitwise, knit until you have 1 stitch left, knit up the loop and work it through the back loop knitwise,  
Knit 1 = 2 increases = 5 stitches.

Make increases every 6th row until your work measures approx. 29.5 inches (75 cm).  
This is the middle of the work.

### **Start decreasing**

Decrease 1 stitch at each side like this:

Knit 1, knit 2 together, knit until you have 3 stitches left, knit 2 together, knit 1 = 2 decreases.

Decrease every 6th row until you have 5 stitches left.

### **Last decrease**

Knit 1, slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit 2 stitches together, lift the slipped stitch over, knit 1 = 3 stitches left.

Knit 2 rows.

Bind off.
