



Po - Neck Warmer

Materials

1 skein of Alpaca Bris color 327

Circular needle: 31.5 inches (80 cm) / US size 10 (6 mm)

Stitch markers

Yarn quality

Alpaca Bris, Viking Garn

60% baby alpaca, 11% merino wool, 29% nylon/ 1.8 oz. (50 g) = 164 yards (150 meter)

Knitting gauge in rib: knit 1, purl 1
18 stitches and 25 rounds on 4" (10 cm)

Sizes

One size

Measurements

Neckline, circumference: 15.7 inches (40 cm), measured without being stretched

Length: 9.4 inches (24 cm)

Pattern information

The neckwarmer is knitted top down, in the round on circular needle using the magic loop technique. Hereafter, increases are worked in purl stitches.

Pattern

Cast on 72 stitches and knit in the round using the magic loop technique. Magic loop in rib: purl 1, knit 1.

Knit until your work measures 5.9 inches (15 cm).

Start increasing

Note: From here on, you knit the rib as the stitches show.

1. round: *purl 1, yarn over, knit 7 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 9 yarn overs.

Note: in the next round, the yarn overs are knitted as purl stitches and rib is knitted as the stitches show.

2. round: *purl 2, knit 7 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 81 stitches.

3. round: *purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, yarn over, knit 5 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 9 yarn overs.

4. round: *purl 2, knit 1, purl 2, knit 5 stitches of rib* repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 90 stitches.

5. round: *purl 2, knit 1, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, yarn over, knit 3 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 9 yarn overs.

6. round: (*purl 2, knit 1*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, knit 2 stitches of rib), repeat () a total of 9 times = 99 stitches.

7. round: (*purl 2, knit 1*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, purl 1, yarn over, knit 1) repeat () a total of 9 times = 9 yarn overs.

8. round: *purl 2, knit 1*, repeat from * to * a total of 36 times = 108 stitches.

Note: now, you alternately have 2 purl stitches and 1 knit stitch on the round.

9. round: *purl 1, yarn over, 11 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 9 yarn over.

On the next round, the yarn-over is purled and the rib is knitted as the stitches show.

10. round: *purl 3, knit 10 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 117 stitches.

11. round: *purl 3, knit 1, purl 1, yarn over, knit 8 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 9 yarn over.

12. round: *purl 3, knit 1, purl 3, knit 7 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 126 stitches.

13. round: *purl 3, knit 1, purl 3, knit 1, purl 1, yarn over, knit 5 stitches of rib*, repeat from * to * a total of 9 times = 9 yarn overs.

14. round: (*purl 3, knit 1*, repeat from * to * a total 3 times, knit 3 stitches of rib), repeat from () a total of 9 times = 135 stitches.

15. round: (*purl 3, knit 1*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, purl 1, yarn over, knit 2 stitches of rib), repeat () a total of 9 times = 9 yarn overs.

16. round: *purl 3, knit 1*, repeat from * to * a total of 36 times = 144 stitches.

Bind off loosely as the stitches show.
