



## Magic Colors Vest

No. 1006-201-2525

**Sizes:** S, M, L, XL, XXL.

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Crochet Hook:** 4 mm (US size G)

**Materials:** Stitch markers

**Yarn:** Magic Sock Wool in color  
Northern Light (22)

**How much yarn do you need?**

**S** - 3 skeins

**M** - 4 skeins

**L** - 4 skeins

**XL** - 4 skeins

**XXL** - 5 skeins

**Gauge:** 9 V st = 10 cm

12 rows in V st = 10 cm

**Abbreviations used in this pattern:**

**ch** - chain

**dc** - double crochet

**V st** - V stitch - 2 dc in the same st

**st(s)** - stitch (es)

## Final Measurements

The final measurements of the vest are listed below. The pattern is available in 5 sizes from S to XXL and is written in US terms.

	Small	Medium	Large	X-Large	XX-Large
<b>Bust circumference - cm</b>	86	96	106	116	126
<b>Width - cm</b>	55	60	65	70	75
<b>Length - cm</b>	62	62	62	62	62

### Pattern notes:

- The Magic Colors Vest is made from 2 identical panels that are sewed together.
- The ch 3 at the beginning of the row counts as the first dc.
- The length of the foundation chain divided by 2 gives you the length of the vest.
- For the foundation you will need a multiple of 2+1 sts.



## Pattern

### Right panel

#### Row 1

Ch 225 sts for the foundation chain. Ch 3 more sts and starting and in the 6<sup>th</sup> st from the hook make 1 V st, [skip 1 st, 1 V st]. Repeat [-] to the end of the row. Finish the row by skipping the second to last st and put 1 dc in the last stitch. Ch 3 and turn.

#### Row 2

Put 1 V st between the 2 dc's of the V st from the previous row. Repeat to the end of the row. Finish the row with 1 dc in the 3<sup>rd</sup> st of the turning ch. Ch 3 and turn.

Next, repeat row 2 until you have in total:

- **S** – 33 rows
- **M** – 36 rows
- **L** – 39 rows
- **XL** – 42 rows
- **XXL** – 45 rows

Fasten off and repeat the same pattern for the **Left Panel**.

## Assembling

### Joining the panels to make the back side

Lay the panels next to each other, with the foundation chains facing each other. Starting from the bottom, join 55 V sts to create the back panel. Leave the remaining 56 V sts for the front panel.

### Joining the sides

Fold the piece in half. Starting from the bottom, join 35 V sts to sew the sides together. Leaving 21 V sts for the arm holes. Repeat for the other side.

### To finish

Add an edge around the vest by making 2 rounds of sc.

Weave in all the ends and block the vest to fit the measurements.
