



# **Heart pillow**

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## Materials

3 balls Woolpower col. 02, off-white 1 ball Woolpower col. 16, red

Circular needle 80 cm/ 4 mm Stitch markers Pillow, kapok fibers 40 x 50 cm

## Yarn

**Woolpower**, Happy Sheep 100 % wool/ 100 g = 160 meters

Gauge 18 stitches x 22 rows = 10 cm

## Measurements

Width: 48 cm Height: 39 cm

## Pattern information

The pillow is worked back and forth on a circular needle. The heart is worked using the intarsia technique = 1 small ball for each side. The pillow is folded double, the seam is at the bottom of the backside.

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Have fun making this pattern!



### Pattern

CO 91 stitches with the circular needle and off-white. Work stockinette stitch back and forth. Work 5 cm. Insert marker A in each side = bottom of the pillow.

Work 5 cm. Insert a marker **B** in each side = seam on the pillow.

Continue until piece measures 18 cm.

#### Now you work the heart.


Work according to the diagram.

Begin by counting 45 stitches and work the next stitch (the middle stitch) in red, work the remaining 45 stitches.

Continue working the diagram, and twist the yarn strands on WS as you change colors.

Work with 2 balls off-white and 1 ball red on the first part of the heart and hereafter you have 3 balls off-white and 2 balls for the top part of the heart.

The heart measures 14 cm in height.

After finishing the diagram, you work 12 cm with off-white. Insert marker **C** in the side = top of the pillow.

Continue until piece measures 34 cm = measured in between **C** and **B**.

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Bind off all stitches in k stitches from RS. Weave in ends.

#### Assembly

The seam is 5 cm from edge below. **NB** Don't forget to wash and block piece before assembling the pillow.

Sew the first 6-7 cm of CO-edge to BO-edge on each side together in Kitchener stitch. The remaining part is sewn together when the pillow has been placed inside.

Fold the piece double, WS of both pieces facing each other and marker **A** and **B** are on top of each other. Marker **C** is the fold on top of the pillow. Sew the sides together from RS.

Place pillow inside the pillowcase and sew the remaining part of the seam together.
