## Elben - Child socks

No. 2004-201-8120

## Materials

1 (1) 2 skeins Atlas Happy Feet Print col. 02

Double pointed needles size $2,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ Stitch markers

## Yarn

Atlas Happy Feet, Hobbii
75\% SW Wool, 25\% Nylon/
$100 \mathrm{~g}=420$ meter

## Size

Shoe size: 30/31 (32/33) 34/35
Length foot: approx. 18 (20) 22 cm

## Gauge

28 stitches $\times 38$ rounds $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in pattern.

## Abbreviations

$\mathrm{St}(\mathrm{s})$ : stitch(es)
p: purl
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together.
k2tog tbl: knit 2 stitches together but work through back loop.

## Pattern information

The sock is worked in stockinette stitch with a pattern along instep and top of the foot. You work the pattern according to a diagram.
The sock has no rib edge and the pattern begins in the first round.

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Have fun making this pattern!

## Shaft

CO 48 (52) 52 stitches and distribute them on 4 double pointed needles.

## Knit 1 round.

Insert a marker at the beginning of the round (between needle \#1 and \#4) and another marker in the middle of the round.
NB The pattern diagram has 22 stitches. This means you insert a marker 11 stitches from the marker in the middle of the round, on each side.

## Begin working the pattern according to diagram

Work the pattern over these 22 stitches and stockinette stitch over the remaining stitches. Continue like this until piece measures approx. 10 (11) 12 cm . Finish after the $10^{\text {th }}$ round of the pattern.

## Divide for heel

The round begins between needle \#1 and \#4.
Knit the first 12 (13) 13 st on needle \#1. Gather the stitches on needle \#1 and \#4 = 24 (26) 26 heel-stitches on the same double pointed needle.
Rest the stitches for the foot/instep on needle \#3 and \#4.

## Heel

Work stockinette stitch back and forth over the 24 (26) 26 st for the heel, until it measures $3,5(4) 4,5 \mathrm{~cm}$. Finish with a WS row. Insert a marker in the middle of the heel after 12 (13) 13 st. Measure the foot from here.

## Decrease for the heel as follows:

$1^{\text {st }}$ row (RS): Work until there are 7 (7) 8 st left, k2tog tbl, k1, turn.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ row (WS): Work until there are 7 (7) 8 st left, p2tog, p1, turn.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row (RS): Work until there are 6 (6) 7 st left, k2tog tbl, k1, turn.
$4^{\text {th }}$ row (WS): Work until there are 6 (6) 7 st left, p2tog, p1, turn.
Continue working 1 stitch less before decreasing until all stitches on needle are
worked. On next round, continue in stockinette stitch and pick up 11 (12) 13 st on each side of the heel. Distribute the heel-stitches over 2 double pointed needles.

## Heel gusset and pattern on instep

Insert a marker in the transition between heel and instep on each side.
Decrease for the gusset as follows: knit until 2 st before marker, k2tog, work the stitches for the instep in pattern until second marker, k2tog tbl, work the rest of the round.

Work 1 round.
Continue decreasing like this in every $2^{\text {nd }}$ round until you have 48 (52) 52 stitches.

## Foot

Continue working in pattern and stockinette stitch until piece measures approx. $15(16,5) 18$ cm from marker in heel = you still need to work $3(3,5) 4 \mathrm{~cm}$ for the toe.
NB! Here you finish the pattern. The toe is worked in stockinette stitch.

## Toe

Insert 1 marker in each side, meaning you will have 24 (26) 26 st on both sides of the foot.
Work until marker.

## Begin decreasing as follows:

$1^{\text {st }}$ round: $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ double pointed needle:
$\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{k} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ tbl, k until 3 st before marker, k2tog, k 1 .
$3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ double pointed needle:
$\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{k} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ tbl, work in knit stitches until 3 st before marker, k2tog, k1.
Work 1 round.
Continue decreasing in each side on every $2^{\text {nd }}$ round until there are 12 (14) 14 st left.

BO all stitches. Sew the hole in the toe together in Kitchener stitch.
Work another sock in the same way.
