



Ella - Children's Sweater

No. 2004-201-1867

Materials

1 (2, 2, 2, 2) skein of Fandango col. 03

Double pointed needles size 5 mm
Circular needles size 60 and 80 cm, 5 mm

Yarn

Fandango, Hobbii
60% wool, 40% acryl/ 200 g = 500 meters

Gauge

19 stitches and 26 rounds = 10 x 10 cm
in stockinette stitch on needle 5 mm

Size

4 (6, 8, 10 12) years

Measurements

Width: 33 (35, 37, 39, 41) cm
Length: 42 (44, 46, 48, 50) cm

Abbreviation

Inc 1 stitch: Pick up the yarn in between the stitches and k tbl.

Pattern information

The sleeves are worked first, to ensure that body and yoke are worked with the same color transition.
The sweater is worked bottom up.

Sleeve

Rib edge

CO 36 (38, 40, 42, 44) stitches on double pointed needles. Join piece and work in the round.
Work 4 cm rib: k1, p1.
Insert a marker at the beginning of the round.

The sleeve

Continue in stockinette stitch. Work 2 rounds.

Begin increasing: Work until 1 stitch before the marker, inc 1 stitch, k2, inc 1 stitch = 2 stitches increased.

Increase on every 10th (10th, 10th, 12th, 12th) round until you have 48 (50, 52, 54, 56) stitches.
Continue until the piece measures 30 (33, 36, 38, 40) cm.

Armhole

Bind off 6 stitches on the last round as follows:

Bind off the last 3 and the first 3 stitches on the round = a total of 6 stitches = 42 (44, 46, 48, 50) stitches. Break the yarn. Put piece aside.

Second sleeve

Work one more sleeve in the same way.

Body

Rib edge

CO 124 (132, 140, 148, 156) stitches on circular needle size 60 cm. Join piece and work in the round.

Work 4 cm rib: k1, p1.

Insert a marker at the beginning and in the middle of the round = sides = 62 (66, 70, 74, 78) stitches on each piece.

Continue in stockinette stitch until the piece measures 25 (27, 28, 30, 31) cm.

Armhole

Bind off 6 stitches on the last round as follows:

Work until 3 stitches before the first side marker, bind off 6 stitches, work until 3 stitches before the second side marker and bind off 6 stitches = 56 (60, 64, 68, 72) stitches on each part.

Don't break the yarn.

Now you work the sleeves together with the body and decrease for the raglan.

You may change to circular needle size 80 cm and use the Magic Loop-technique.

Work the back piece, the first sleeve, the front piece and the second sleeve = 196 (208, 220, 232, 244) stitches.

NB Insert a marker in each transition. The decreases for the raglan are made on each side of these markers.

1st round: k1, k2tog tbl, *work until there are 3 stitches left before the marker, k2tog, k2, k2tog tbl*, repeat from * to * 2 more times, work until 3 stitches before the marker, k2tog, k1 = 8 stitches decreased.

2nd round: knit all stitches.

Repeat these 2 rounds until there are 84 (80, 84, 88, 84) stitches left.

On the next round, decrease 4 (0, 0, 4, 0) stitches evenly = 80 (80, 84, 84, 84) stitches.

Neck edge

Work 2 cm rib: k1, p1.

Bind off in rib with an elastic bind off.

Finish

Sew the openings under each sleeve together.
