## Emerald - Domino Shawl

## Materials

1 ball Twister col. 35
Circular needle $80 \mathrm{~cm} / 3,5 \mathrm{~mm}$
Stitch markers (are used as stitch holders)

## Yarn

Twister, Hobbii
55\% Cotton, 45\% Acrylic/
$250 \mathrm{~g}=1000$ meter

## Gauge

22 stitches on 10 cm in garter stitch

## 1 domino:

Width, diagonal: 23 cm
Height: 23 cm

Size
One size

## Measurements

Width: 140 cm
Length: 70 cm

## Pattern information

This shawl is worked from the tip and up, making new domino squares alternately on each side of the middle.
Work back and forth on the circular needle. Work until you have 3 domino squares in the middle. Along the edge you work half domino squares (triangles).

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Have fun making this pattern!

## Explanation

k3tog: slip 2 stitches knitwise, k1 and pass 2 slipped stitches over knit stitch.

Please note: You can see a diagram of the domino squares on page 6.

## Pattern

Domino 1
CO 75 st op and work in garter stitch.
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: k all sts.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ row: slip 1 stitch purlwise, k35, k3tog, k36.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ and all uneven rows: slip 1 stitch purlwise, $k$ remaining sts.
4. needle: slip 1 stitch purlwise, k34, k3tog, k35.
6. needle: slip 1 stitch purlwise, k33, k3tog, k34.

Continue like this; decreasing in the middle of the domino until there are 3 st left, $\mathrm{k} 3 \mathrm{tog}=$ 1 st left.
Don't break the yarn but slip stitch on to stitch holder.
Continue with domino 2.

## Domino 2

Pick up 38 stitches along the left side of domino 1, CO 37 new stitches $=75$ stitches. Work domino 2 in the same way as domino 1 , until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and slip stitch on to stitch holder.
Continue with domino 3.

## Domino 3

CO 38 stitches and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $1=75$ stitches. Work domino 3 in the same way as domino 1 , until there is 1 stitch left.
Don't break the yarn but slip stitch on to stitch holder.
Continue with domino 4.

## Domino 4

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 3, slip the stitch from domino 1 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $2=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 5

CO 38 stitches along the left side of domino 2 and CO 37 new stitches $=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 6

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 4, slip the stitch from domino 2 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $5=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 7

CO 38 stitches and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $3=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Don't break the yarn but slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 8

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 7, slip the stitch from domino 3 on to the needle and pick 37 stitches along the right side of domino $4=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 9

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 8 , slip the stitch from domino 4 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $6=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and bind off.
The left side of the shawl is now finished.

## Domino 10

Pick 38 stitches along the left side of domino 5 and CO 37 stitches $=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn and slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 11

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 6, slip the stitch from domino 5 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $10=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn.
Bind off.

## Domino 12

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 9 , slip the stitch from domino 6 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches op along the right side of domino $11=75$ stitches.
This is a half domino square, so you also k2tog in each side:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: k all sides.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ row: slip 1 stitch purlwise, k2tog, k33, k3tog, k33, k2tog and k1 = 71 stitches.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row and all uneven rows: slip 1 stitch purlwise and knit remaining stitches.
$4^{\text {th }}$ row: slip 1 stitch purlwise, k2tog, k31, k3tog, k31, k2tog and k1.
Knit the domino until you have 7 stitches left.
Next row: knit
Next row: k2tog, k3tog, k2tog = 3 stitches.
Next row: pull the second and third stitch over the first stitch $=1$ stitch.
Break the yarn and weave in ends.

## Domino 13

Pick up 38 stitches along the left side of domino 10 and CO 37 new stitches $=75$ stitches. Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn.
Bind off.

## Domino 14

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 11, slip the stitch from domino 10 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $13=75$ stitches.
This is a half domino square and is worked in the same way as domino 12.
Break the yarn and weave in ends.
Bind off.

## Domino 15

Pick up 38 stitches along the left side of domino 13 and CO 37 new stitches $=75$ stitches. This is a half domino square and is worked in the same way as domino 12.
Break the yarn.
Bind off.

## Domino 16

CO 38 stitches and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $7=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Don't break the yarn but slip stitch on to stitch holder.

## Domino 17

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 16, slip the stitch from domino 7 on to the needle,
Pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $8=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn.
Bind off.

## Domino 18

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 17, slip the stitch from domino 8 on to the needle, pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $9=75$ stitches.
This is a half domino square and is worked in the same way as domino 12.
Break the yarn and weave in ends.
Bind off.

## Domino 19

CO 38 stitches and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $16=75$ stitches.
Continue working the domino until there is 1 stitch left.
Break the yarn.
Bind off.

## Domino 20

Pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino 19, slip the stitch from domino16 on to the needle and pick up 37 stitches along the right side of domino $17=75$ stitches.
This is a half domino square and is worked in the same way as domino 12.

## Break the yarn.

Bind off.

## Domino 21

CO 38 stitches and pick up 37 stitches along the left side of domino $19=75$ stitches.
This is a half domino square and is worked in the same way as domino 12.
Break the yarn.
Bind off.
Weave in ends. You can also block the shawl if you want.
