



Forest Shawl

Measure: 130 cm x 68 cm **Skill Level:** Beginner

Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm (US size I)

Yarn: Manaya - in color Navy/Purple/Forest

Green/Mint (05)

How much yarn do you need?

1 skein

Gauge: 17 sts = 10 cm

17 rows = 10 cm

In the pattern 1 sc, ch 1, skip next st

Abbreviations used in this pattern:

Ch - chain

Dc - double crochet **Sc** - single crochet

Inc - Increase (1 sc, ch 1, 1 sc in the same

ch-sp)


St(s) - stitch(es)

Sp - space



Final Measurements

Final measurements of the shawl are listed in the diagram below. If you want a bigger or smaller shawl just make more or fewer rows.



Skills

This is a beginner pattern. The techniques involved are single crochet, chain stitches, double crochet and increasing.

The shawl is worked from the left corner to the right corner and the triangle shape is obtained by increasing only in one side, at the end of the row, every second row.

Pattern

R1: ch 5, 1 sc in the 3rd st, ch 1, skip next st, 1 sc in last st. Ch 2 and turn.

R2: skip 1st sc, *1 sc in next ch-sp, ch 1, skip next st* Repeat to the end of the row except last ch-sp. Finish the row with 1 Inc. Ch 2 and turn.

R3: skip 1st sc, *1 sc in next ch-sp, ch 1, skip next st* Repeat to the end of the row. Ch 2 and turn.

R4 – R90: repeat R2 and R3

At the end of R90, ch 4 and turn

R91: skip 1st sc, *1 dc in next ch-sp, ch 1, skip next st* Repeat to the end of the row. Ch 2 and turn.



R92-R102: repeat R2 and R3

At the end of R102, ch 4 and turn

R103: repeat R91

R104 – R122: repeat R2 and R3

At the end of R122, ch 4 and turn

R123: Repeat R91

R124 – R136: Repeat R2 and R3

At the end of R136, ch 4 and turn.

R137: Repeat R91

R138 – R156: Repeat R2 and R3

At the end of R156, ch 4 and turn

R157: repeat R91

R158 – R160: Repeat R2 and R3

Fasten off.



Tassels

- 1. Wrap yarn around cardboard 20 times.
- 2. Thread tapestry needle with about 30 cm of yarn and tie top of tassel snugly. Remove needle, leaving tie to attach to work.
- 3. Cut ends of yarn and remove from cardboard.
- 4. Thread tapestry needle with 40 cm of yarn and wrap around tassel 6–10 times, snugly. Tie knot in wrap yarn and bury end inside tassel.
- 5. Trim tassel ends evenly.
- 6. Attach to Shawl in all 3 corners

To finish

Weave in all ends.
