Materials

Baby Cotton
Crochet hook 3 mm
15 mm button

Yarn usage

Approx. 20g

Gauge

24 sts x 10 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Abbreviations

Ch: Chain stitch

St(s): Stitch(es)

Mr: Magic ring

Dc: Double crochet

Bl: Back loop of stitch

Sc: Single crochet

Sl st: slip stitch

Please note:

Work is turned with 3 chain stitches, that replaces 1 double crochet.

Every other row is worked in the back loops of the stitches, i. e. rows 2, 4, 6, and so on.

Pattern instructions – Guide with pictures can be found at the end of the instructions

1. Make a mr. Ch 3 and 8 dc into the ring. (9)
2. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in same st, 2 dc in every st to end of row. (18)
3. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in same st, 1dc in next st. *2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next st *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (27)
4. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (36)
5. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 3 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (45)
6. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 4 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (54)
7. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 5 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 5 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (63)
8. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 6 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (72)
9. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 7 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 7 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (81)
10. Turn work and ch 35. Make 1 dc in 4th st from the hook, dc in next st. * Ch 1, skip 1 st and dc in the next 3 sts *. Repeat between ** 5 times in total. Ch 1, skip 1 st and dc in the last ch sts.
Working in bl, * 2 dc in next st, dc in the next 8 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row.
11. Do NOT turn. Ch 1, sc around the top edge of the bib and the buttonhole “snip” (along the neckline).
When you have worked around the ”snip”, you can continue sc all around the edge, end with a sl st into the first sc.

Or make a picot edge along the lower edge of the bib like so:

* Ch 2, sl st into the 2nd st from the hook, skip 1 st, sc in next st *. Repeat between ** around the edge and end with a sl st into the first sc of the top edge.

Sew the button to the corner opposite the buttonhole “snip”.



Guide

Row 1



1. Make a mr, ch 3.



2. make 8 dc into the ring. (9)

Row 2



1. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in same st.



2. Like so.



3. Make 2 dc in next st.



4. make 2dc in every sts to end of row. (18)

Row 3



1. Ch 3 and turn work.



2. make 1 dc in same st.



3. Like so.



4. Dc in next st.



5. *2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next st *.



6. Repeat between ** to end of row (27)

Row 4



1. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work.



2. Dc in same st.



3. Like so.



4. Dc in the next 2 sts.



5. * 2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts *.



6. Repeat between ** to end of row. (36)

Row 5



1. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 3 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (45)

Row 6



1. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 4 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (54)

Row 7



1. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 5 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 5 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (63)

Row 8



1. This row is worked in bl. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st. 1 dc in each of the next 6 sts, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts *. Repeat between ** to end of row. (72)

Row 9



1. Ch 3 and turn work. 1 dc in the same st.
1 dc in each of the next 7 sts, *2 dc in next
st, dc in next 7 sts *. Repeat between ** to
end of row. (81)

Row 10



1. Turn work and ch 35.



2. Dc in the 4th st from the hook.



3. Like so.



4. Dc in the next st

5. * Ch 1, skip 1 st and dc in the next 3 sts
*.



6. Repeat between ** 5 times in total.



7. Ch 1, skip 1 st and dc in the next 9 sts.



8. Working in bl, * 2 dc in next st, dc in the
next 8 sts *.



9. Repeat between ** to end of row.

Row 11



1. Do NOT turn work, but adjust the angle a bit.
Ch 1.



2. Sc around the top edge of the bib and the buttonhole "snip" (along the neckline).



3. When you have worked around the "snip", you can continue sc all around the edge, end with a sl st into the first sc.

Or make a picot edge along the lower edge of the bib like so:



4. Ch 2,



5. Sl st in the 2nd st from the hook.



6. Like so.



7. Skip 1 st, sc into the next st.



8. Like so.



9. Ch 2.



10. Sl st in the 2nd st from the hook.



11. Skip 1 st.



12. Sc in the next st.



13. Like so.



14. * Ch 2, sl st into the 2nd st from the hook, skip 1 st, sc in next st *. Repeat between ** around the edge and end with a sl st into the first sc of the top edge..



15. Like so. Cut yarn, weave in ends and sew on button.
