



# **Nougat - Sweater**

#### **Materials**

6 (6, 7, 7) skeins of BabyWool, col. 02 (A) 8 (8, 9, 10) skeins of BabyWool, col. 18 (B)

Circular needle, 80 cm, 5 mm og 6 mm Stitch holder with wire, 2 pcs Stitch markers

# Yarn quality

**BabyWool**, Happy Sheep 100% wool/ 50 g = 165 meters

Knitting gauge, with slight stretch 22 sts og 21 rounds = 10 cm with 2 strands in twisted rib on 6 mm needle.

# Size

S (M, L, XL)

Measurements, with slight stretch

Width: 42 (46, 50, 54) cm Length: 60 (60, 60, 60) cm

#### Pattern information

The sweater is worked in twisted rib and will stretch in width. Choose size from the given measurements for S to XL. The sweater is worked in the round, from the top and down, and it is there that it can be customized in terms of length and width.

Work with 2 strands of yarn. First 2 stands of col. A, then one of col. A and one of col. B, then lastly, two strands of col. B.

## Techniques and stitches

#### **Increases**

Make 1 knit (m1k): Pick up the bar between stitches and knit through the back loop.

Make 1 purl (m1p): Pick up the bar between stitches and purl through the back loop.

#### **Decrease**, in rib

Work until a knit stitch. Slip 2 stitches (together), purl one stitch, pull the slipped stitches over the purled stitch.

You have now decreased 2 stitches, and there are 3 knit stitches beside each other. These are knit until next decrease.

#### Decrease, in knit stitches

Work until the 3 knit stitches. Slip 2 stitches (together), knit 1 stitch through back loop, then pull the 2 slipped stitches over the knit stitch. You have now decreased 2 stitches, and the rib is worked all the way around.

#### **Pattern instructions**

#### **Neckline**

#### All sizes

Cast on 104 sts on a 6 mm circular needle with 2 strands of color A.

Work with the magic loop technique in twisted rib: k1 tbl, p1.

Continue until neck measures 4cm in length.

#### Yoke

Place a marker around the first stitch, count 13 sts (sleeve) and place another marker around the next st. Count 37 sts (back) and place marker around next st, count 13 sts (sleeve) and place marker around next st, then count 37 sts (front) until the first marker = 4 marked sts.

**NB** Increases are worked on each side of these marked sts to create a marked line along the raglan increases.

**Round 1:** Between the last and first st of the round, m1k, then k tbl of marked st and m1k.

\* work twisted rib until marked st, m1k, k tbl of marked st, m1k \*. Repeat between \*\* until you have increased on both sides of each marked st = 8 increases = 112 sts.

Round 2: Work k over k and p over p.

Round 3: Between the last and first st of the round, m1p, then k tbl of marked st and m1p.

\* work twisted rib until marked st, m1p, k tbl of marked st, m1p \*. Repeat between \*\* until you have increased on both sides of each marked st = 8 increases = 120 sts.

**4. omgang:** Work k over k and p over p.

Repeat these 4 rounds until you have worked 40 rounds of color A.



Switch one of the strands of color A for a strand of color B = mixed colors.

Continue with the increases until there are 59 (65, 71, 77) sts on each of the sleeves and 83 (89, 95, 101) sts on the back and front + 4 marked sts = 288 (312, 336, 360) sts. End on a round without increases.

#### Separate sleeves from body

Place the 59 (65, 71, 77) sts of the sleeve + 1 marked st on either side on a wire stitch holder or a piece of yarn to rest. Cast on 11 (13, 15, 17) underneath the sleeve, work the back, place the 59 (65, 71, 77) sts of the sleeve on a wire stitch holder or piece of yarn to rest. Cast on 11 (13, 15, 17) sts underneath the sleeve and work the front = 188 (204, 220, 236) sts for the body.

Work in twisted rib until you have made 40 rounds of mixed colors.

Switch out the strand of color A for a strand of color B = solid color.

Work until you have made 30 rounds of solid color B.

Switch to a 5 mm circular needle.

Continue until you have made 40 rounds of color B in all. Bind off loosely in twisted rib.

#### **Sleeves**

Pick up 11 (13, 15, 17) sts along the cast on edge under the sleeve = 72 (80, 88, 96) sts. Work in the round in twisted rib with a strand of each color, using either the magic loop technique or double pointed needles.

Place a marker in the middle, under the sleeve.

On the first round, decrease on either side of the picked up sts.

Decrease every 8 rounds according to the explanation under "techniques and stitches" above the pattern instructions.

Decrease 8 times, so there are 54 (62, 70, 78) sts, AT THE SAME TIME as you switch to two strands of color B when you have worked 40 rounds of mixed colors in all.

Work until you have made 30 rounds of solid color B = 54 (62, 70, 78) sts.

Switch to a 5 mm circular needle or double pointed needles.

Continue in twisted rib until you have 40 rounds of solid color B in all. Bind off loosely in twisted rib.

Work the other sleeve in the same manner.

Weave in ends.
