



Vivi - Cropped Vest

Materials

5 (6, 7, 8) skeins Snowstorm col. 18

Circular needles 80 cm/ 6 mm and 8 mm

Yarn quality

Snowstorm, Hobbii

100% Wool/ 50 g = 50 meters

Knitting gauge

12 sts og 17 rounds = 10 cm on an 8 mm
needle

Sizes

S (M, L, XL)

Measurements

Width over chest: 42 (46, 50, 54) cm

Length: 49 (50, 52, 53) cm

Pattern information

This is a cropped and fitted model. The vest is worked in the round until the armholes, then worked flat. Armhole edges and neckline is worked in reverse stockinette stitch

Ribbed edge

Cast on 84 (94, 104, 114) sts on a 6 mm needle.
Work 8 cm rib: k1, p1.

Body

Switch to an 8 mm needle and work in stockinette.
Work 4 rounds.
Place a marker at each side = 42 (47, 52, 57) sts for each part = side seams.

Increase round

* k until 2 sts before marker, yo, k4, yo *. Repeat between ** once more = 4 increases.
Make 7 rounds of stockinette, working the yo's tbl on the first round.
Repeat these 8 rounds 4 times in total = 100 (110, 120, 130) sts.
Continue in stockinette until the body measures 29 (29, 30, 30) cm.
There are 50 (55, 60, 65) sts on each part, front and back.

Armholes

On the next round, bind off stitches for the armhole like so:
* k until 3 (4, 5, 6) sts before the side seam marker, place 6 (7, 8, 9) sts on a stitch holder *.
Repeat between ** once more, then k to end of round = 44 (48, 52, 56) sts for each part.

Back

Work the back over the 44 (48, 52, 56) sts and let the other sts rest.
Row 1 (WS): purl.
Row 2 (RS): ssk, k until there are 2 sts left of row, k2tog = 42 (46, 50, 54) sts.
Repeat these 2 rows another 1 (2, 3, 4) time(s) = 40 (42, 44, 46) sts.

Continue in stockinette until the armhole measures 18 (19, 20, 21) cm. End on a WS row.

NB Bind off the shoulder sts and place the neckline sts on a holder, like so:

Shoulder

10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

RS: Bind off 10 (11, 12, 13) sts, k rest of row.

WS: Bind off 10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

Neckline: Place the remaining 20 (20, 20, 20) sts on a stitch holder for the neck.

Front

Place the yarn to the work and begin from WS.

Row 1 (WS): purl.

Row 2 (RS): ssk, k until there are 2 sts left of row, k2tog = 42 (46, 50, 54) sts..

Repeat these 2 rows another 1 (2, 3, 4) time(s) = 40 (42, 44, 46) sts.

Continue in stockinette until the entire work measures 35 (36, 38, 39) cm. End on a WS row.

Neckline

RS: k 15 (16, 17, 18) sts and turn, let the remaining sts rest.

Left shoulder

WS: purl.

Right side: k until 2 sts are left on the needle, k2tog.

Repeat these two rows until there are 10 (11, 12, 13) sts left.

Continue in stockinette until the armhole measures 20 (21, 22, 23) cm.

Place a marker in the armhole edge = shoulder.

Work another 2 cm of stockinette. End on a WS row.

Bind off.

Place 10 (10, 10, 10) sts on a stitch holder.

Right shoulder

RS: k 15 (16, 17, 18) sts.

WS: purl

RS: ssk, k the remaining sts.

Repeat the last two rows until there are 10 (11, 12, 13) sts left.

Continue in stockinette until the armhole measures 20 (21, 22, 23) cm.

Place a marker in armhole edge = shoulder.

Work another 2 cm of stockinette. End on a WS row.

Bind off.

Finishing and edges

Sew up the shoulder seams.

Armhole edges

Place the 6 (7, 8, 9) sts from the armhole on a 6 mm needle, then, working from RS, pick up about 50 (52, 54, 56) sts along the armhole edge.

Purl from the RS (= reverse stockinette) in the round (using the magic loop technique).

Work 4 rounds in total.

Bind off in purl.

Neckline edge

Place the 20 sts of the neck on a 6 mm needle, pick up sts along the shoulder neckline edge, k the 10 sts of the front neckline, pick up sts along the other shoulder neckline edge, so that you have 66-70 sts in total for the neckline edge.

Purl from the RS (= reverse stockinette) in the round (using the magic loop technique).

Work 4 rounds in total.

Bind off in purl.
